

Mr. Grant worked 33 years for the family of Dwight W. Morrow, former U.S. senator and ambassador to Mexico,

We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways. at the summer estate on North Haven. Morrow's daughter, Anne Spencer Morrow, married Charles A. Lindbergh, the famous aviator.

Mr. Grant worked as a gardener and at a variety of other jobs, and for the last 12 or 14 years he was the caretaker. He went to work on the estate after high school, and was there from 1925 until 1943. During the war he worked for a time at a shipyard in Camden.

Charles Lindbergh was a frequent visitor to

the Morrow estate, and Mr. Grant became friendly with the Lindbergh family.

"When Lindbergh came down courting the Morrow girk, be brought his plane in on a little field there," said Mr. Grant's brother, Lawrence. "My brother and I used to help Lindbergh turn his plane around and tie her down. We got on the other end of a cross-cut saw with him to cut down some trees to widen the landing field. That was before they had chainsaws."

"It was quite a place," said Lawrence Grant. "It was on the north shore of the island. The Morrows bought it from our grandfather. Owen lived in the old farmhouse near the entrance to the estate."

Mr. Grant met his wife, Mary Beattie Grant, when she came to Maine one summer as an employee of the Morrows. The Morrows, who often spent the entire summer on the island, had several employees, including a yachtsman and chauffeur.

During the war, Mr. Grant worked a short time at J.O. Brown's Boat Yard on North Haven. Shortly after the war, he returned to the position of caretaker at the Morrow estate, where he worked until 1958.

He later worked for the Strong and Morgan families, retiring in the 1970s.

Born on North Haven, a son of Irving and Bessie Waterman Grant, he was a 1925 graduate of North Haven High School.

He was a member of the Moses-Webster Masonic Lodge on Vinalhaven, and he enjoyed gardening and
