## THEODORE H. GRANT

**PRESQUE ISLE** - Theodore Hudson Grant, 84, died June 7, 1996. He was born in Houlton, May 12, 1912, the son of Helen Porter Grant and Gilbert Grant. He attended public schools in Hodgdon and Houlton, and earned a BS degree in electrical engineering from the University of Maine in 1939. Ted's first steady job was teaching radio at a National Youth Agency School at Eastport. In December of 1940, he was hired as an electrical engineer by Maine Public Service Co. in Presque Isle. Soon afterwards, he was asked by the University of Maine, Orono, to interest young men and women in radio and to teach a course in Presque Isle. He did this two nights per week and at least two of his students pursued careers in radio. Shortly after World War II was declared, Ted went to work for the FCC in Melis, Mass. He monitored distress radio signals from ships and passed the messages on to the Navy headquarters in Boston. Later, in 1942, he was a training officer at a radio school for the Merchant Marine on Gallups Island in Boston Harbor and held the rank of lieutenant junior grade in the Maritime Service. In 1944, Ted was transferred as a full lieutenant to Hoffman Island in New York, where he helped to set up a new radio school for the Maritime Service. After the war in 1945, he returned to Presque Isle, where he was chief engineer for Maine Public Service until 1969, when he became vice president of engineering. He remained with Maine Public until his retirement in 1978. Ted was very active in community life in

Presque Isle. He worked with Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts. He was president of the Chamber of Commerce in 1970 and served two terms on the Presque Isle Recreation Board, and was treasurer of the Squa Pan Outing Club for 10 years. He served on the Presque Isle Sewer Board for many years and from 1957 to 1987, was on the Presque Isle Planning Board. From 1978 to 1992, he served on the Board of Directors of Maine Mutual Insurance Co. He was also an active member of SCORE, chairman of the Prestile Water Treatment Board from 1973 to 1975, was a more than 50-year member of Masonic Blue Lodge and was a member of the Shrine. He was an active member of the Kiwanis Club for many years, serving in many offices, including president. Ted was also an avid hobbyist. He produced many quarts of Squa Pan maple syrup each year for 20 years. He was an accomplished woodworker, building a clock for each of his children. He fished, especially for Atlantic salmon, whenever possible. In the past two years, he taught himself how to use a computer, and most recently, began surfing on the Internet. He is survived by his beloved wife of 57 years, Margaret Commeau Grant; son, Richard and his wife, Christine of Webster, N.Y.; son, Tucker and his wife, Anne of Westlake Village, Calif.; daughter, Pamela and her husband, Paul Chenea of Wayne; daughter, Martha and her husband, Rodney Thompson of Presque Isle; son, Frank of Presque Isle; 3 grandchildren. Memorial services will be announced at a later date by Duncan Graves Funeral Home, Presque Isle.

**Parsonsfield, Aug. 18.** — Harvey D. Granville, 74, former legislator, educator and lumber operator and prominent York County farmer, died at his home here today. He had been in failing health for the last two years.

Mr. Granville, during his legislative career in both House and Senate, was a member of the farm group and sponsored the bill creating third class roads and led the battle for the passage of the first gasoline tax measure. He was a life-long resident of this town.

He was born Jan. 7, 1874, the son of Rufus and Caroline Pentz Granville, and received his education in the town schools and at Parsonsfield Seminary from which he was graduated in 1892. He had been a member of the Board of Trustees of the seminary since 1915 and a vice president and chairman of the executive board for the last 20 years.

He taught 15 years and was first principal of Porter High School and was later principal of Bean Memorial High School at Brownfield. He also served as superintendent of the Porter and Parsonsfield schools.

As a member of the Legislature he served at one time as Republican floor leader, was House chairman of the Committee on Ways and Bridges, a member of the Committee on State Lands and Forest Preservation and chairman of the House Committee on Military Affairs and Public Utilities Committee.

Mr. Granville fathered the law permitting towns to close in winter time roads infrequently used whose opening in many instances would have resulted in heavy expense to the taxpayers. He was an ardent advocate of farm-to-market roads.

He was widely known for his work in reforestation, seeding more than 500 acres of otherwise worthless land in this area to pines.

In his forties, he became interested in the lumber industry and was head of the Sokokis Lumber Company, which at one time employed more than 50 men. In more recent years he had been affiliated with the Maine Road Equipment Company of Portland.

He was owner of one of the largest apple orchards in York County. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of Drummond Lodge of Parsonsfield and of the Knights of Pythias Lodge at Kezar Falls.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Alice Fox Granville; four grandchildren, Richard D. and David F., both employed at the Saco-Lowell shops, Biddeford, Philip D., with the army air forces at San Antonio, Tex., and Beverly of this town; two great-grandchildren and a sister, Mrs. Elizabeth G. Plummer of Parsonsfield. A son, Harry F., died April 27, 1945.

Funeral services will be held at the home at 2 p. m. Saturday.

In 1983-84, when he was principal of Kennebunk Junior High, the school won the Excellence in Education Award from the U.S. Department of Education.

Mr. Graves was a veteran of the U.S. Army. He served in Germany for two years.

He was a communicant and active member of St. Joseph's Church in Biddeford, and member of the Kennebunk Rotary Club and the York Lodge of Masons in Kennebunk. He was a summer reserve officer for the Wells Police Department for seven years.

## Philip E. Graves

### lawyer, former Saco court judge

SACO - Philip E. Graves, 82, of 25 Stockman Ave., a lawyer here for more than a half century, died Saturday at his home.

He was the son of Dr. Roscoe Stockbridge Graves and Maud Ellen Andrews Graves.

Each day the Press Herald selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Graves attended Saco schools and graduated from Thornton Academy in 1929. He also graduated from the former Peabody School of Law in Portland.

Mr. Graves served as city solicitor here in 1938-39, and was appointed judge of the Saco Municipal Court in 1941.

Two years later, he resigned to join the U.S. Merchant Marine.

Mr. Graves first had sought admission to the Coast Guard or the Navy, but was turned

down because of faulty color perception. He sought waivers so he could join a service, but his appeals were denied.

Mr. Graves was a member and past master of the Saco Masonic Lodge, the Maine Council, R. & S.M., and the Biddeford-Saco Lodge of Elks.

He also was former commodore and life member of the Saco Yacht Club.

"My father really loved the water," Joseph Graves said. "For years he had a small aluminum boat, with motor, and he would take it down the (Saco) river to the ocean. In recent years, he would go up river. He said it wasn't as crowded.

"From his days in the Merchant Marine to all the times on the river, I think you could say this was his real love."

Mr. Graves attended Trinity Episcopal Church in Saco.

Besides his son, he is survived by his wife of 59 years, Sarah Bridge Graves of Saco; one daughter, Martha Graves Frager of Gorham; and four grandchildren.

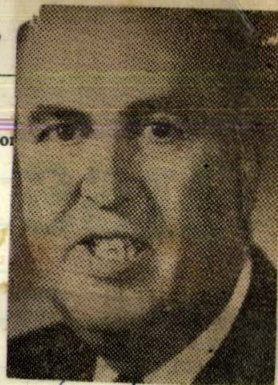

**KENNEBUNK** — Samuel Sidney Graves, 82, of Brown Street, a former major league baseball player, died Monday at a Biddeford hospital.

Mr. Graves, formerly of Marblehead, Mass., was the husband of Marion Johnstone Graves.
