He fished, especially for Aflantic salmon, whenever possible. In the past two years, he taught himself how to use a computer, and most recently, began surfing on the Internet. Mr. Granville, during his legis-lative career in both House and Senate, was a member of the farm group and sponsored the bill creating third class roads and led the battle for the passage of the first gasoline tax measure. He was a life-long resident of this was a life-long resident of town.

He was born Jan. 7, 1874, the son of Rufus and Caroline Pentz Granville, and received his education in the town schools and at Parsonsfield Seminary from which he was graduated in 1892. He had been a member of the Board of Trustees of the seminary since 1915 and a vice president and chairman of the executive board for the last 20 years.

He taught 15 years and was first principal of Porter High School and was later principal of Bean Memorial High School at Brownfield. He also served as superintendent of the Porter and Parsonsfield schools.

As a member of the Legislature

As a member of the Legislature he served at one time as Republican floor leader, was House chairman of the Committee on Ways and Bridges, a member of the Committee on State Lands and Forest Preservation and chair-man of the House Committee on Military Affairs and Public Utilities Committee.

Mr. Granville fathered the law permitting towns to close in winter time roads infrequently used whose opening in many instances would have resulted in heavy expense to the taxpayers. He was an ardent advocate of farm-to-market roads.

He was widely known for his work in reforestation, seeding more than 500 acres of otherwise worthless land in this area to

pines.

In his forties, he became interested in the lumber industry and was head of the Sokokis Lumber Company, which at one time employed more than 50 men. In more recent years he had been affiliated with the Maine Road

Equipment Company of Portland.
He was owner of one of the largest apple orchards in York County. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of Drummond Lodge of Parsonsfield and of the Knights of Pythias Lodge at Lodge of

Kezar Falls.





in Germany for two years.





"It was a test of lights, not a game of blind man's bluff," Mr. Graves recalled.

The city of Lynn once held "Sid Graves Day" in honor of Mr. Graves, who also was inducted into the Maine Baseball Hall of Fame in 1975.

He was a member of the Masons in York.

Mr. Graves, who retired in 1963 from the Marblehead post office, came here in 1972 and was a member of St. David's Episcopal Church.

Surviving are his wife of 47 years and a son, Eugene M. Graves, both of Kennebunk; a sister, Marion Graves Mansfield of Marblehead, and two grandchildren.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. tomorrow in St. David's Episcopal Church. The Rev. Clifford Geiger will officiate. Burial will be in Hope Cemetery.
