For several years he was associated with an Augusta construction company and in his youth worked for agencies in Rumford and Pennsylvania. He was owner of Phillips and Webb Lumber Company here many years.

Gray, was graduated from Westbrook High School in 1913, where he starred on all the athletic teams, and attended the University of Maine, where he was a member of the Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity.
