## Rufus E. Gray

Standish, July 16—Rufus E. Gray, 85, a clothing manufacturer at West Gorham and Standish prior to his retirement 40 years ago, died at his home here Saturday after a long illness.

Born at Cornish Oct. 14, 1859, Mr. Gray had lived here 62 years, coming from Denmark, Me., where he passed his youth. He was the son of the late Erastus and Abbie (Jack) Gray. Since his retirement he had engaged in farming.

He and his wife would have celebrated their 57th wedding anniversary July 24. Besides his widow, he is survived by two half-sisters, Mrs. Jennie Furlong of Limerick, and Mrs. Fannie Cobb of Portland; by two half-brothers, Charles Gray of Portland and Bert Gray of Boston, and by three daughters, Mrs. Alice Dow,

Mrs. Blanche Nason and Mrs. Au Perkins, all of Standish. There seven grandchildren and 13 grandchildren.

Mr. Gray attended the Standish Congregational Church and was past master of Standish Lodge of Masons and a past patron of Dawn of Hope Lodge, OES. He served several terms on the board of selectmen and was for many years secretary of the Dow Corner Cemetery Association.

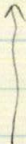

**PRESQUE ISLE —** Fred C. Greaves, 84, who the Saturday Evening Post said in a Feb. 14, 1953 article held 26 municipal jobs in four Maine communities at one time, calling it "a record for Maine and probably all mankind," died Wednesday at a local nursing home.

He was a past master and life member of Molunkus Lodge of Masons, Sherman Mills, and a past president and life member of the Meduxnekeag Club in Houlton.

At one time, Mr. Greaves was town manager of as many as five small Maine communities simultaneously, most of them in southern Aroostook County. While still manager of the towns of Linneus and Hodgdon, neighboring communities of Houlton, he served six years on the Houlton Town Council, the last year as its chairman.

## **Merle 'Mike' Greaves**

### **supervised many Maine highway projects**

**STILLWATER** — Merle "Mike" Greaves, 80, died Sunday at home.

He was born in Silver Ridge, Aroostook County, a son of Stanley and Margaret Howe Greaves. He was a graduate of Sherman High School.

He took a job with H.E. Sargent Inc. in 1935 as a laborer that led to a long and successful career in the highway construction industry. He became timekeeper, superintendent, then general superintendent.

Mr. Greaves was an original corporate director of Yankee Constructors Inc. and in 1982 was elected director of that Sargent-affiliated company. Through the years he supervised the construction of many highway projects in Maine, including several World War II national-defense airfields and the Harris station hydro-electric project.

In the 1960s he was responsible for the formation and overall operation of Sargent's Bituminous Paving Division, and supervised the paving of many miles of highway for the Maine Turnpike Authority.

In October 1987 he accepted the Maine Transportation Achievement Award for dedicated service toward the development of Maine's transportation system.

After an illness and subsequent semi-retirement in 1985, he remained an active consultant for the Sargent companies. He was awarded a 50-year Veteran's Medal from the Star of the East Masonic Lodge of Old Town. He was a member of the Stillwater Federated Church, where he was a deacon, member of the finance committee and chairman of the trustees.

At home he enjoyed gardening, yard work and maintaining a small pond.

Surviving are his wife of 57 years, Barbara Patterson Greaves of Stillwater; two daughters, Jennifer Sagalyn of Lenox, Mass., and Ellen Whiting of Doylestown, Ohio; a sister Mildred Yeomans of Newton, N.C.; a half-brother, George Greaves of Dexter; and two grandchildren.

Masonic memorial services will be held at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday at Brookings-Smith, LaBeau Chapel, 72 Main St., Orono, conducted by the officers and members of the East Lodge of Old Town. James W. Greely, 73, pioneer motion picture theater manager in Maine, died Sunday in a local hospital after a short illness.

Active for more than 30 years in the amusements industry in this city, Mr. Greely opened the first motion picture house in Portland in 1907. His activities in the entertainment world saw him operate several theaters after he opened Dreamland. He was connected with his own Greely's Theater, New Portland, Colonial and Jefferson theaters and operated a roller skating rink during the last war.

Inspector Leroy L. Greely, 50, a member of the Portland Police Department since 1930, died at a local hospital today after a brief illness.
