BOOTHBAY HARBOR — Lt. Col. Raymond R. Greenleaf, 61, died here Monday in an area hospital.

He was born here, the son of Lewis Sheldon and Jessie Boston Greenleaf, and graduated from Boothbay Harbor High School. He attended the University of Maine, University of Wisconsin, Northeastern University and graduated from Suffolk with a B.A. in business administration.

He served in the Army during World War II as a medic and received two Bronze Star medals for heroic duty. He also was an Army Air Force veteran of the Korean conflict. He was a patrolman with the Boothbay Harbor Police Department.

In 1953, he began a grocery business in Boothbay Harbor with his mother. From 1953 to 1980, he worked for J. Edward Knight Insurance Co.; he later became owner.

From 1954 to 1957 he was a member of the Maine House of Representatives. He was Director of Lincoln County Civil Defense during the same period, as well as a member of the Boothbay Harbor Water Commission.

He was chairman of the eastern advisory board of the Canal National Bank. In 1967 he was selected as an out-

MONSON — Robert L. Greenleaf, 73, husband of Dagmar (Ryder) Greenleaf, died Nov. 23, 1993, at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Togus. He was born in Monson, Nov. 13, 1920, the son of Archie and Bessie (Spinney) Greenleaf. He was a graduate of Monson Academy, Class of 1939. He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the U.S. Army Air Corps as a tail gunner aboard a B-17. He was incarcerated as a prisoner of war in a German prison camp for 14 months. He was a recipient of both the Air Medal and the Purple Heart. He was a self-employed master electrician and served the entire Moosehead Region for many years. He was a deputy for the Piscataquis County Sheriff's Department for more than 25 years. He served as the constable for the Town of Monson for more than 30 years and was a former member of the Monson Volunteer Fire Department. GREENLEAF FAMILIES IN MAINE.

Moses Greenleaf was the son of Hon. John Greenleaf of Newburyport, (who was a member of the continental congress) born May 19, 1755. He married Lydia Parsons of Newburyport in 1776. He was a captain in the Revolutionary army, 1776 to 1781. He and his father were eminent shipbuilders, and built 22 ships and brigs between 1781 and 1790. In 1790 Moses Greenleaf bought a farm in New Gloucester and moved there, and was afterwards a farmer. He was a man of ability, and his sons were also, although neither of them had a collegiate education. At the Centennial celebration at New Gloucester, there was such a wealth of material that the Greenleaf family received but little mention. Moses Greenleaf died Dec. 18, 1812. His children, all born in Newburyport, were:

1. Moses, Jr., born 1777, settled in New Gloucester, merchant, moved to Bangor in 1804, and from thence to Williamsburg about 1810. In 1816 he prepared the first map of Maine ever made in the state, with a book accompanying, entitled "Statistics of Maine." In 1829 he enlarged, added to, and amended the book as a "Survey of Maine," a volume of 468 pages, and at the same time issued a new and more complete map. To him the county of Piscataquis is largely indebted for the discoveries of slate. His works are rare and valuable. He was an associate justice of the court of sessions for Penobscot county. He died March 20, 1834, aged 57, with an unblemished reputation and universally lamented. His sons removed to the West.

2. Clarinda, married Eleazer A. Jenks of Portland, printer. He moved to Brownville, and was a merchant.

3. Ebenezer, a master mariner and a man of great natural and acquired abilities. He abandoned the sea and removed to Williamsburg, prior to 1809. He was a good land surveyor. He died Nov. 29, 1851.

4. Simon Greenleaf, born Dec. 5, 1783, educated in the schools of New Gloucester.

Born in Lodz, Poland, Mr. Greenman came to the United States in 1907, settled in New York City, and used his language skills as a salesman, catering to foreign customers.

In 1915 he moved to Rumford where he owned a chain of five clothing stores and was a founder of Temple Israel.

Following his move to Portland in 1941, Mr. Greenman owned and operated a credit clothing business. In 1962 he purchased the Gray Gull Gift Shop on Congress Street, which he owned until his retirement in 1976.

He was a 60-year member of the Knights of Pythias and a former chancellor commander, a 50-year 32nd Degree Mason, a former director of the Jewish Home for the Aged where for several years he conducted services, a former director of Shaarey Tphiloh Synagogue and chairman of its religious committee, a director and regional vice-president of Mizrahci of New England, and a director of the Jewish Federation of Portland.

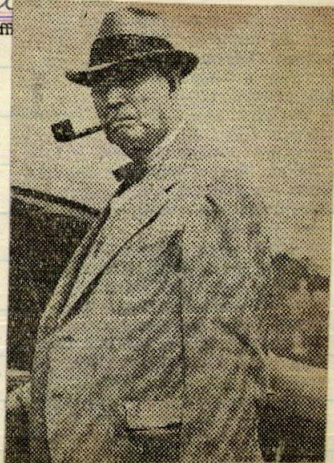

Boothbay, Harbor, Dec. 1.—Dr. George A. Gregory, 81, practicing physician and surgeon here for 55 years and founder of St. Andrew's Hospital, died today following an illness of several months.

Dr. Gregory, who was also prominent in the Masonic bodies and in civic affairs, was born at Shelburne, N. S., the son of John and Sarah Acker Gregory. He was graduated from the Maine Medical School at Bowdoin College in 1891, and following graduation came to Boothbay Harbor and established his practice. He founded the hospital in 1908.

He was a member of the Lincoln and Sagadahoc Medical Societies, the Maine Medical Association and was a fellow of the American College of Surgeons. For 32 years he was medical examiner for Lincoln County until 1944, when the duties were taken

over by his son, Dr. Philip O. Gregory. In 1941 he received the gold medal of the Maine Medical Association awarded physicians with 50 years of practice.

He was chairman of the Republican town committee and was a member of the Governor's Council in 1919-21. Since 1933 he had been a director of the Depositors Trust Company.

Dr. Gregory was a 32nd degree Mason, a member of Seaside Lodge, of Pentecost Chapter, Royal Arch Masons, of which he was a past high priest, and of the Knights Templar. He was also an honorary member of the Rotary Club.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Elizabeth Ricker Gregory; two sons, Dr. Philip O. and George, jr., a pre-medical student at Dalhousie University, Halifax, N. S., and two daughters, Miss Selma
