Dr. Donald Gribbin, 75, of Littlejohn Island died Monday at a local hospital.

Charles E. Griffin, 67, retired Portland fireman, died yesterday in Togus Veterans' Hospital. He had been a patient there eight weeks. He had been living with a daughter, Mrs. Margaret Floyd, 68 Inverness St.

Mr. Griffin was born Sept. 9, 1888, on Long Island, eldest son of the late George W. and Georgianna Fowler Griffin. He attended elementary schools on Long Island and was graduated from Portland High School. He married Nettie Fanning of Lubec who survives, in 1919.

Mr. Griffin was a conductor for the Cumberland County Power and Light Co. before he joined the Army in World War I. He joined the Portland Fire Department in 1919 and retired Sept. 15, 1950. He served many years on the fire boat.

Capt. Melville Eldridge Griffin, 65, retired captain of the Portland Fire Department, which he served from 1899 to 1933, died today in his home on Willow Street, Peaks Island. For several years he was ranking officer of the Peaks fire station.

Born in Portland, Nov. 28, 1872, Captain Griffin was educated in the Portland public schools and for several years before he entered the Fire Department was employed by the Lovell Dry Plate Company on Cross Street as a dry-plate maker. The Rev. Mr. Griffiths held pastorates in Dawn and in Carleton, N.Y., before coming to Maine as pastor of the Hebron Baptist Church in 1916, and then from 1918 to 1923 at the Camden Baptist

Church.

He taught history at Colby College from 1923 to 1945, and served as pastor of the South China Community Church for 27 years, retiring in 1962.

He was Monmouth's oldest citizen at the time of his death and was holder of the Boston Post Cane. He was a member of the Masons and held the Grand Lodge of Maine's 50-year Veteran's Medal.

His wife, Esther F. George Griffiths, died in 1974.

Survivors include a son, Arthur M. of Monmouth; four grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
