# HARRY S. GRINDALL

WINSLOW — Harry S. Grindall Sr., 81, prominent in Maine Masonic circles, died Saturday at a Waterville hospital.

He was a graduate of Lee Academy, attended the University of Maine, and was a veteran of World War II. He owned and operated Lincoln Clothing Co. for many years, until his retirement 16 years ago. Francis was very active in local affairs, in which he was past president and secretary of the Rotary Club; secretary of Lincoln Citizens Association (formerly Lincoln Development); served as a treasurer of the Lincoln Chester Bridge Committee, the Lincoln Merchants and the Woolen Mill Financial Group; and served on the Budget Committee and the Planning Board. As a mason, he was a member of the Blue Lodge and of the Chapter. He was past patron of Lin-

coln Chapter No. 112 OES. He served as a director of the Lakes District Council for Boy Scouts, where he served on the Executive Board.
