

The Rev. Daniel I. Gross, D. D., 70, for 12 years paster of the Woodfords Congregational Church until his resignation in 1930, and widely known and honored in Portland, died Sunday in the Deaconess Hospital, Boston, after an illness of several weeks. He had been pastor of the Congregational Church at Athol, Mass., since 1931.

Called by another clergyman "the ideal minister," Dr. Gross was well known in church circles, taking active part in all church and local affairs.

A native of Orland, he attended Thornton Academy, Saco, and the State University at Boulder, Colo., and returned to Maine to graduate from Bowdoin College. In 1922 he received the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity from Bowdoin. After two years at Harvard Law School, he entered Andover Theological Seminary, preaching as a licentiate at the Immanuel Church of Beverly, Mass., while completing his studies at the seminary. Ordained and installed at Marshfield, Mass., he preached at the Pilgrim Church of Nashua, N. H., coming to Portland from that city in 1918.

He was former president of the General State Conference and Missionary Society of Maine, a member of the National Commission on Missions, several times delegate to the National Council of Congregational Churches of America and very active in the State Sunday School Associa-

tion.

Surviving besides his widow, who lives at Athol, are a daughter, Mrs. Charles Nelson, Washington, D. C., and a son, Virgil Gross, now stationed in Honolulu.

Funeral services will be held in the Athol Congregational Church at 2

p. m. Wednesday.







OTISFIELD. May 12 (Special) -The body recovered in Lake Thompson early this morning was identified by Medical Examiner William E. Freeman of Yarmouth early this afternoon as that of William Gross of Lisbon Falls. Identification was made positive through papers in the pockets of the clothing, fishing license, Mason receipts and other personal papers. Earlier in the day, before arrival of Dr. Freeman, the body had been identified as that of Joseph Petrellis, also of Lisbon Falls, who drowned with Gross, Sunday.) Deputy Sheriff George R. Bryant of Portland and Deputy Sheriff Sanford Annis of East Otisfield, located the body, about 70 feet in water, while dragging.




