Chas. E. Gurney, 71, of 33 Kenwood Street, a practicing attorney here since 1900, and former chairman of the Maine Public Utilities Commission, died Sunday in a local nursing home. Ill since last March, he had been a patient

in the nursing home for three months. He was a member of the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine at Orono, his alma mater, and past president of the Maine Bar Association.



Mr. Gurney was born in Portland Feb. 15, 1874, son of Charles E. and Jennie Hunnewell Gurney. He was educated in the Portland public schools, including Portland High School, which he left in his freshman year, following the death of his parents. Ambitious for an education, he completed his preparation for college largely by outside study and entered Colby in the Fall of 1894, being graduated in 1898.

He read law in the office of Symonds, Cook & Hutchinson, meanwhile teaching school, and was admitted to the Cumberland County Bar in 1900.

Interested in politics from his youth, Mr. Gurney participated in Republican campaigns as a party worker. In 1916 he was elected one of Portland's seven Representatives to the State Legislature and was elected to the State Senate in 1918. After entering his sec-

ond term in 1921 he was elected its president upon Percival P. Baxter automatic Chief Executive of Gov. Frederic H. 31, his 25th day

In October, Baxter appointed chairman of the Commission and term, declining He then returned

office. He was a former of the Citizens Adv. of the local Salv. its chairman seven

A 32nd degree past master of AF&AM, and a Portland Commander. plar, among other order. He was a

Portland Lions Club, the Woodfords Club and Delta Kappa Epsilon Fraternity.

In World War One he was a member of the Four-Minute Speakers group in promoting the sale of War and Victory Bonds and President Wilson named him one of three members of District Two Advisory Board in this city.

Mr. Gurney married the former Gertrude Barton of Waterville June 27, 1901. Surviving besides her are a son, Capt. Marshall Barton Gurney, USN, who is expected here today on emergency leave from his station in California, and a daughter, Mrs. Winslow L. Jones of Park Ridge, Ill., who arrived in Portland Sunday evening.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Wednesday in the First Parish Unitarian Church with the Rev. G. Ernest Lynch officiating. Interment will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Portland.
