"They scraped by here, trying to make ends meet," she said. "But they made sure the three boys in the family all went to college."

Mr. Hague attended the University of Maine at Orono, where he was a pre-med major. While in college, he became involved with the ROTC program and upon graduation received a commission as a second lieutenant. He

then trained at the Command General Staff School at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

Mr. Hague served in the Army during the Korean War and was stationed in Japan. He later joined the Army Reserve, retiring as a lieutenant colonel.

He returned to Gorham, where he lived for the next 35 years, and went to work as an account executive and stockbroker for Advest Inc.

"But he loved the military," Ms. Hancock said. "What he enjoyed most was the sociability of the service."

Even after he left the military, Mr. Hague remained active in service organizations. He was treasurer of the Southern Maine Chapter of the Reserve Officers Association and past president of the Portland Chapter of National Sojourners, a past

commander of the Military Order of World Wars and a member of the Maine Coast Guard Officers Club. He also worked with the Stephen Manchester Post and American Legion.

Mr. Hague's work for CIOR, an organization of retired reserve officers from NATO nations, also took him to several European countries for two weeks each summer.

"For seven or eight years in the 1970s and 1980s, we went to congresses held all over Europe," Ms. Hancock recalled.

In addition to his service-related clubs, Mr. Hague was involved in community, civic and fraternal organizations, including the Cumberland Club, the Portland Club and the Woodfords Club. He was past president of the Westbrook-Gorham Rotary Club and a member of Harmony Ledge Masonic Lodge and the Kora Shrine, Lewiston. He was also treasurer of the Maine State Society for the Protection of Animals and a member of the Maine Charitable Mechanics Association.

A lifelong Republican, Mr. Hague served as a representative from Gorham in the 100th session of the Maine State Legislature.

In addition to Ms. Hancock, survivors include a nephew, G. Eric Hague of Oviedo, Fla.; and two nieces, Lisa H. Ball of North Wilkesboro, N.C., and Karin L. Hague-of-Hastings on Hudson, N.Y.
