Bangor, Nov. 18.—Oliver L. Hall, 75, Rockland native and veteran newspaperman, died Sunday in his home at Hampden.

He had been managing editor of the Bangor Daily Commercial, was executive secretary to Gov. Lewis O. Barrows from 1936 to 1938 and state librarian from 1938 to 1942, also serving as a director of the Port of Portland while state librarian.

MT. VERNON — Raymond A. Hall, 84, a master farmer who influenced many young people, died Thursday after a long illness.

PASSAGES

Each day, the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Hall had lived all of his life on his family's 650-acre farm on North Road. The farm has been in his family for more than 150 years.

Mr. Hall bred, raised and milked registered Holsteins and bought and sold hay throughout New England and eastern Canada. His herd and his farm were a source of great pride and he was a "stickler for details" when it came to their upkeep, said his son, Richard, who farmed with his father.

Mr. Hall tolerated no ugly peeling paint, unnecessarily sloppy pens or unsightly broken boards, his son said.

Mr. Hall was a community-minded man who donated the land for the Mount Vernon Elementary School and the Town Hall. He also served at various times as a town selectman, treasurer, tax collector and planning board member.

Mr. Hall liked working with young people, knew just how much responsibility to give them, and was able to convey to them the intricacies of agricultural science, said Mark Tucker, who began working for Mr. Hall at age 11.

"He was a great soil scientist. Because of him, I steered my career toward agriculture and many others did, too," said Tucker, now 37 and an employee of Grant's Dairy Inc. in Bangor.

"He grew tremendous hay crops," Tucker said. "When I was in college, I used to brag that I worked for the 'hay king' of Maine.... When I think of him, I also think of his value system. He measured people by their work ethic and their thought processes. He was extremely sharp."

Mr. Hall also was a patriotic man who willingly gave the government what it asked for, said his son Richard.

"There wasn't one penny made on his farm that did not get reported to the IRS," his son said. "He was as honest as anyone I will ever meet."

Mr. Hall was born in Mt. Vernon, a son of Charles A. and Marcie Robinson Hall. He grew up in Mt. Vernon and graduated from Traip Academy in Kittery and Bliss College in Lewiston. He married Mildred Wadleigh of Mt. Vernon.

Mr. Hall contributed to many farm organizations and his community. He was County DHEA president and state director, County ASCS chairman, County Farm Bureau director, County Extension Executive Committee member, Farmington Farmer's Union director, Agri-Mark representative and hauling committee member, former Green Pastures winner, and County Conservation Family. He also was a member of the Mill Stream Grange #674 and a 50-year plus member of Vernon Valley Masonic Lodge #96 and Vernon Valley Chapter #68, O.E.S.

In addition to his wife of 55 years and his son, he is survived by a daughter, Pearl Ames of Windrop; a grandson, Jeffery Ames of Raleigh, N.C.; and two granddaughters, Renee and Rachel Hall of Mt. Vernon.

A funeral service will be held at 11 a.m. Monday at Roberts Funeral Home, 26 Bowdoin St., Winthrop, with Rev. John Dunn officiating. Burial will be in Pine Grove Cemetery, Bolgrade, in the spring.

CAMDEN - Russell Hall, 86, longtime owner of J.C. Curtis Hardware on Main Street, died Wednesday at a Belfast hospital.

Mr. Hall retired in 1976 after 27 years in the hardware business.

In 1949 Mr. Hall left his job as manager of Scribner's Publishing Co.'s Boston office to return to his native Maine, where he became owner and operator of J.C. Curtis Hardware.

The hardware business was a natural fit, said his daughter, Carol Ann Olsen. "He had an extensive knowledge of tools and hardware, and he enjoyed meeting people. He was really an old-fashioned hardware person."

Mr. Hall kept the store open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. "If people needed things, he would make deliveries after hours," said his daughter. On Fridays and Saturdays he kept the store open until 9 p.m. On Sundays, he would do office work and sharpen skates and knives.

Mr. Hall was an original member of the local morning coffee club that started at Libby's Drug Store about 40 years ago. The group met at several locations, the latest of which was Boynton-McKay Drug Store.

"It was always 10 or 12 of them," said his daughter. "Sometimes members died and new members came along. Some would leave for the winter."

David Hartman of the television show "Good Morning America" once featured the club members in a segment on Maine.

As a young man, Mr. Hall worked for Scribner's in New York City. He later relocated to Springfield, Mass., and sold school textbooks for Scribner's throughout New England. Later he was promoted to manager of the publishing company's Boston office.

Mr. Hall was a member of Amity Lodge of Masons, the Camden Rotary, the Camden Businessmen's Club and was a director of the Camden Snow Bowl.

He served on the building committee and boards of both Camden Community Hospital and the Camden Health Care Center.

Born in South Windham, he was a graduate of Portland Country Day School. He graduated in 1933 from Bowdoin College.

Surviving are his wife of 59 years, Elizabeth Halladay Lord of Camden; two daughters, Carol Ann Olsen of Waterville and Heide Halladay Hall of Portsmouth, N.H.; a son, Russell Hall III of Laguna Niguel, Calif.; a sister, Harriet Yates Tyson of Campbelltown, Pa.; four grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 9 a.m. Friday at the Camden Health Care Center Auxiliary room. Burial will be private. Arrangements by Laite & Pratt Funeral Home.

Col. Vernon W. Hall, USA, ret., 66, native of Portland and resident of this city in his early life, died suddenly last Thursday in the MacCormack General Hospital in Pasadena, Calif.

He had visited his brother, Alfred E. B. Hall of Saco for five days early in June, making the trip from the Pacific Coast by motor, and suffered a slight shock the day of his return to Southern California.

Born in Portland, May 14, 1882, son of the late Albert B. Hall, former local insurance man, and Clara C. Hall, Colonel Hall received his early schooling here,

He was interested in military matters from early boyhood and was a captain in the High School Cadets. He also enlisted in Co. B, First Maine Infantry, and continued with it when it became the Coast Artillery, MNG.

He was employed as a clerk in the office of the late Charles F. Flagg, investments, and when the United States entered World War One in 1917 he was captain of Second Company, CAC, and went overseas with the 54th Artillery, CAC, in March, 1918, serving in the AEF until the close of the war.

Promoted to major the following September, he vacated that commission and accepted a captaincy in the regular army, being promoted to major Aug. 1, 1935; lieutenant colonel, July 26, 1940, and later to colonel. He served as military instructor at the University of Maine and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Boston, among other assignments, and his foreign service included the Panama Canal Zone and Hawaii.

During World War Two he was on the staff of General Miles, commanding the north-eastern area in the United States, with headquarters in Boston.

He was a member of the Masons, a past master of Ancient Land-Mark Lodge, also a member of Greenleaf Chapter, RAC; Portland Council, R&SM, of which he was a past illustrious master; Portland Commandery, Knights Templar; and the Maine Consistory, SPRS.

Colonel Hall never married, but as result of his interest in youth he adopted and educated a boy, now Major James M. Hall, USA. He is survived also by his brother at Saco, two grandchildren and several cousins.

His brother has received no information as to plans for funeral services and burial.
