Willis B. Hall

Gorham, April 11.—Willis B. Hall, 78, 18 South Street, former practicing attorney in Portland and son of the late one-time Maine Secretary of State Joseph Blake Hall, died here today.

A Republican, Mr. Hall formerly was a member of the Industrial Accident Commission. He was representative to the Legislature from Caribou from 1907 to 1909. He was Caribou town clerk for 15 years and a member of the school committee there for six years.

He was known as the father of the juvenile court movement in Maine. He drafted in the Legislature a memorial to Congress urging the immediate passage of a bill for raising the battleship Maine from Havana Harbor. The law shortly afterwards was enacted.

A native of Portland, he was educated in the public schools of Fargo, N. D., St. John's School at Presque Isle and Emerson College of Oratory, Boston. He studied law at Caribou.

He had been grand chancellor of the Grand Lodge of Maine, Knights of Pythias, and vice president general for New England of the National Society, Sons of the American Revolution. He also was a member of the Mayflower Society and was a prominent layman in the Universalist Church.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Bertha M. Hall; a daughter, Mrs. Margaret Cabanne, Boston, Mass.; and one granddaughter.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Monday at 749 Congress Street, Portland. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery in that city.

He was an Army veteran of World War II. He was past master of the Washington Lodge No. 37, Lubec. He was a former selectman of

Augusta, March 8—(AP)—

Frank J. Ham, superintendent of the State Liquor Commission warehouse, former collector of internal revenue for Maine and long identified with Republican politics, died here today. He was 73.

Ham was chairman of the Republican State Committee for 12 years and was also warden of the State Prison for six years. He was also a director of the Depositors Trust Company of Augusta.

Survivors are the widow, Miles F. Ham of Pittsford, one daughter, a brother and two sisters. The funeral will be held Saturday at 2 p. m. at the Ham and Hewins Funeral home here.

Ham was a native of Canada. He came to Augusta 38 years ago following his election as sheriff of Androscoggon County. After serving two years off he became state prison warden and then headed the Internal Revenue Department in Maine until the Winter of 1933.

Following the banking house failure he was instrumental in the formation of the Depositors Trust Company at the closing of the Augusta Trust Company.

Ham was prominent in Masonic circles being a member of Augusta Lodge, F and AM, Royal Arch Chapter, Trinity Commandery, Knights Templar, and a 32nd degree Scottish rite member.

After retiring as internal revenue collector Ham became treasurer of the Republican State Committee and several years under A. Eugene Sewall on the committee.

Gov. Lewis O. Barrows tonight said in the death today of Frank J. Ham the "Republican Party has lost one of its most loyal workers."

The chief executive also said the State of Maine "has lost one of its most widely-known citizens."

"His loss," said Barrows, "will be keenly felt in Augusta, and I shall personally miss his wise counsel and advice."
