Alexander V. Hamilton

priest, rail buff, historian

WHITEFIELD, N.H. — The Rev. Alexander V. Hamilton V, 79, died Friday at his residence, 670 Parker Road, after a sudden illness.

Mr. Hamilton was born in Great Barrington, Mass., son of the Rev. Alexander and Mary Spur Hamilton IV.

A direct descendent of the first U.S. Treasury secretary, Mr. Hamilton grew up in Norwalk, Conn., where he attended grade school. He graduated from the South Kent (Conn.) School, then attended Trinity College and the Neshotah (Wis.) Theological Seminary. He was ordained an Episcopal priest in Milwaukee, and earned a political science degree at Brown University.

The Rev. Hamilton was interested in ancestral societies, among them the New York Society of the Order of the Cincinnati, Sons of the American Revolution, the Mayflower and Huguenot societies, and the Society of Colonial Wars. He also was a Mason at Littleton, N.H., and Kennebunkport, Maine, the Order of the Eastern Star, the York County (Maine) Shrine Club, the Kora Temple Shrine in Lewiston, Maine, and the Elks and Civil Air Patrol.

A rail buff, he served as national president of the Railroad Enthusiasts, Inc., and as both president and chairman of the board of the New England Electric Railway Historical Society, Inc., the "holding company" of the Seashore Trolley Museum in Kennebunkport. He has worked with this trolley museum from its earliest days in the 1930s.

He retired in 1979 and kept active with his societies and served various churches. He has spent a quarter of his time at his home in Kennebunkport, and the rest residing in Whitefield.

Dr. F. W. Hamilton, Portland Native, Dies

Boston, May 22—(AP)—Dr. Frederick W. Hamilton, 80, of Cambridge, grand secretary of the Grand Lodge of Masons in Massachusetts, and former president of Tufts College died today after an emergency operation.

A native of Portland, Me., he was graduated from Tufts in 1880 and received his Doctor of Divinity Degree there 19 years later, 10 years after he had entered the Universalist ministry.

He was pastor of the First Church of Pawtucket from 1889 to 1895, of the First Church, Roxbury, from 1895 to 1906. He served as head of Tufts from 1905 to 1913 and later was a member of the Massachusetts State Board of Education.

BRUNSWICK — Isaac Francis "Ike" Hamilton, 74, of 6 Hemlock Road, a retired merchant marine officer and active member of the Masons, died Thursday at Midcoast Hospital.

Mr. Hamilton served aboard a destroyer escort during World War II and received campaign medals for the

Pacific, European, American and Middle-Eastern theaters. "He got seamanship papers there," said his wife, Jeannette Williams Hamilton.

After the war he began sailing for Waterman Steamship Co. aboard freighters out of New York Harbor to ports all over the world. During his five years with Waterman, he attended several navigational schools and earned a merchant officer's commission.

In 1950, he went t

work for Humble Oil Co., later Esso and then Exxon Corp., and was a second mate for 32 years before retiring in 1982.

He shipped aboard Exxon tankers on the east coast and later in the Middle East and Europe, ending his career sailing from the Alaskan Pipeline in Valdez, Alaska, to California.

Mr. Hamilton shipped at times with Capt. Joseph Hazelwood, skipper of the Exxon Valdez, which ran aground March 24, 1989 in Prince William Sound, causing the nation's worst oil spill.

"He had plenty of wonderful stories," said his wife. "We kept letters going back and forth for all those years. He's been around Cape Horn, Cape of Good Hope, all over the world. He talked about sometimes getting stuck in the mud in the Mississippi River."

Mr. Hamilton was active in the United Lodge of Masons, York Rite Bodies, Montgomery & St. Bernard Royal Arch Chapter, Mt. Vernon Council of Royal and Select Masters and Dunlap Commandery of Knights Templar. He belonged to the Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston, and was a grand chaplain in the Grand Chapter of Maine, Royal Arch Masons.

"The area will miss a personality like that," said Stanley Henderson, a friend and fellow Mason. "His complete friendliness, his straightforwardness. His total love for the Masonic fraternity. If he were given a job, you could depend on him to bring it to completion."

Born in Harpswell, a son of George W. and Annie Johnson Hamilton, he attended Harpswell schools and Deering High School, Portland. He tried for a while to become a professional baseball player and he attended baseball school in 1938-39 in Orlando, Fla.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church, a 55-year member of Merriconeag Grange, Sagadahoc Pomona and the National Grange.

He enjoyed sports, especially hockey and baseball, and attended area high school and Bowdoin College games.

Surviving are his wife of 34 years; two sons, John W. of Brunswick and Robert I. of Wilmington, Conn.; and a sister, Anastasia Beechy of Augusta.

A funeral will be held at 11 a.m. Monday in the United Methodist Church, Raymond and Church roads. The Revs. James Lee McPhee and Susan M. Hoyfield will officiate. Burial will be at Hillcrest Cemetery, Harpswell. Arrangements are by Brackett Funeral Home.
