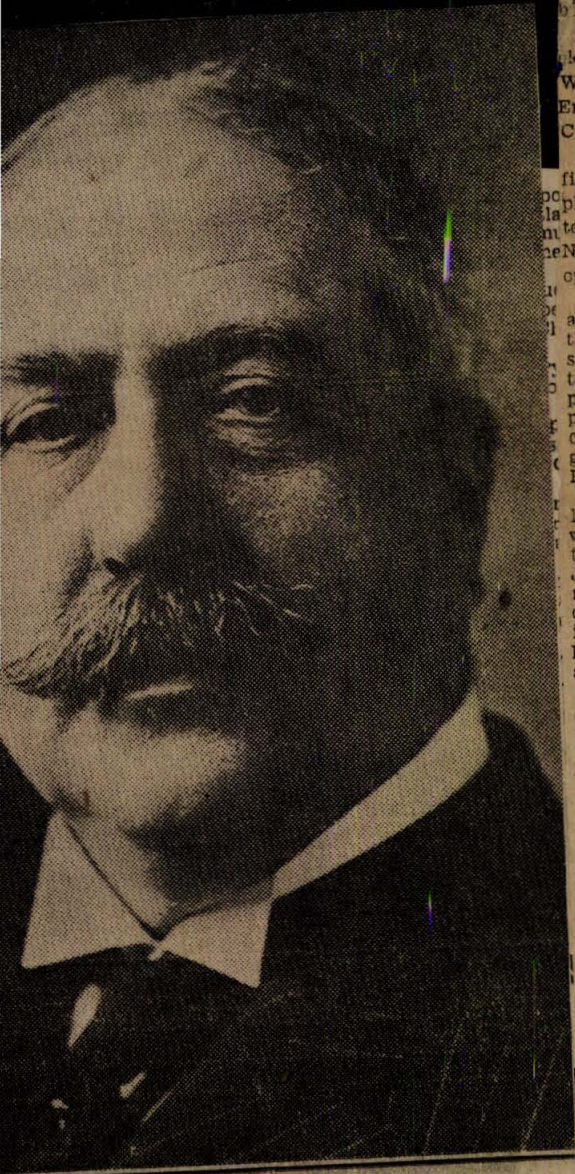

Am wondering if you might have any record of his Masonic membership--or know any Masonic historian in Maine who might furnish us a clue.



He was educated in Brownville public schools and graduated from Brownville Junction High School in 1953. He served in the Air National Guard, Bangor and was honorably discharged. # James B. Hamlin

**silversmith, seaman, tree farmer**

BRIDGTON — James B. Hamlin, 96, a silversmith and tree farmer in North Bridgton who was active in town affairs, died Tuesday at a local nursing home after a long illness.

During the 1930s and 1940s, Mr. Hamlin was a silversmith in New York City. His work has been exhibited in the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York City and the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D.C.



Some of his scale models of instruments designed by Tycho Brahe, a Danish astronomer, were displayed at the 1939 New York World's Fair. He is listed in Who's Who of American Craftsmen.

Mr. Hamlin studied art at Cooper Union and at Pratt Art Institute, both in New York City. He apprenticed under Lauritz C. Eichner, a Danish master. During the 1940s and early 1950s, he was a teacher and head of the silversmithing department at the Craft Students' League in New York City.

In 1953, Mr. Hamlin returned to Bridgton to open a studio. There he taught silversmithing and hand-crafted jewelry, bowls and metal sculptures.

"He tried out many art forms, but he finally settled on silversmithing," said his wife, Barbara Schott Hamlin.

Born in Thacker, W.Va., a son of Fred and Florence Betts Hamlin, Mr. Hamlin was a direct descendant of Hannibal Hamlin of Maine, the Republican vice president under Abraham Lincoln. He graduated from Bridgton Academy in 1918 and Bates College in 1923.

He served on the Bridgton Planning Board and was a member of North Bridgton Congregational Church and the Bridgton Historical Society. He was a former chairman of the Bridgton Academy board of trustees, and he was a prime motivator and curator for many years of the Bridgton Academy Museum. He was also a member of the North Bridgton Volunteer Fire Department and the Masons.

Surviving are his wife of 29 years; three stepsons, Jeffrey S. Dover of Scottsdale, Ariz., G. Kent Dover Jr. of Sanbornton, N.H., and Mark S. Dover of Bremen; and seven step-grandchildren.

His first wife, Willa Frazier Harmon, died in 1963.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at North Bridgton Congregational Church. Arrangements are by Raymond-Wentworth Funeral Home.
