After three years of failing health, Walter K. Hamlin, for 45 years proprietor of Waterford Creamery and one of the most able and influential citizens of Ox'um Lodge of Masons and of Valley Spring Lodge of Knights of Pythias on Dec. 29, at the age of 85, died at his home. He has always been an active participant in all civic matters and has

Born in South Waterford, Dec. 27, 1854, son of John and Mary (Woodsum) Hamlin, he served his town and community in various capacities, maintaining his interest in everything to the end. He spent his whole life in the creamery, was a member of the Methodist Church of South Waterford, and was employed in the creamery for 45 years.

Gifted with unusual mechanical ability and a sound philosophy of life, Mr. Hamlin's delight has always been to be fixing up something, and he was never satisfied with anything short of perfection; whether it was the skilful mending of a broken ob- land states. He has won the esteem of his fellowmen by his honesty, his kindly sympathy, and his devotion to the public good.

On Sept. 9, 1878, Mr. Hamlin married Miss Clara J. Bell of South Waterford, who was his faithful companion for sixty years. She passed on two years ago, soon after their 60th wedding anniversary. Five children were born to them: Mrs. Raymond T. Warren of Portland, Mrs. Arthur L. Sanderson of Harrison, and Mrs. Flora G. Abbott, Mrs. Harry N. Haynes, and Albert W. Hamlin, all of South Waterford. Seven grandchildren also remain to grieve for a kind and dearly loved grandfather.
