Hanson, 64, State Selective Service Director, and formerly for many years adjutant general of Maine, died shortly before noon today in his home at 35 Melville Street. He suffered a heart attack Thursday night after returning from a business trip to Boston.

Born in Belgrade in 1879, he had been a soldier in one capacity or another since old enough

He was a volunteer in the Spanish-American War, with service in the Philippines, and he had been a member of the National Guard of the State of Maine since hostilities ceased between the Filipinos and the United States until his retirement with the rank of major general last Sept. 1.

For years he was adjutant of the third battalion of the Second Maine Infantry and at the beginning of World War I he was

Appointed chief of the State Police in 1927, he served both as adjutant general and State police chief until 1935. He was appointed Maine's Selective Service head in 1941, serving in that office and also as adjutant general until his retirement about two months ago.

His long military career began in 1898 when he enlisted in the First Maine Infantry and it was 22 years later that he became head of the Maine National Guard. Maj. Gen. MAYNARD DELMONT HANSON, 70, oldest active member of the photography business in New England, died today at his residence, 52 Belmont Street. Mr. Hanson was born, May 30, 1866, a Calais, son of Henry L. and Isabelle (Ogilvie) Hanson. He received his education in the public

schools of Unity and Lewiston. On Oct. 24, 1892, he was married to Margaret C. Dorman at Auburn.

The couple had two sons, who survive, Stanley F. and Henry F. Hanson of Portland. Also surviving, in addition to the widow, are one sister, Miss Josephine Hanson, of California, and two grandchildren, Suzanne and Carolyn Hanson of Portland.

Mr. Hanson, whose outstanding hobby was motoring, owned and drove the first automobile in Maine, a Stanley Steamer, which he brought to Portland, July 19, 1899. People came from as far away as Waterville to see Mr. Hanson drive the first horseless carriage through the City streets.

Mr. Hanson was a member of the Photographers' Association of America and was a past president of the Photographers' Association of New England and of the Maine Photo Association. He was in business here for 48 years as a photographer.

His first business association was with the Stanley Dry Plate Company in Lewiston in 1887. From 1888 to 1890 he was with F. E. Stanley, photographer, also in Lewiston. In 1891, he removed to Boston, where he was associated with Sprague and Hathaway, and in 1892 started in business for himself, in this City.
