





## Harold P. 'Jack' Harmon

insurance agent, milk tester

STANDISH - Harold P. "Jack" Harmon, 78, a milk tester, insurance agent and shoe salesman who was listed as missing in action for nine months during World War II, died Thursday at the Maine Veterans Home after a long illness.

"He used to talk about going out over the Alps, and crossing a river into France." Mr. Harmon was hospitalized and fed in France and returned to his base

in England. He was listed as missing in action for nine months, and received a Purple Heart Medal.

After the war, Mr. Harmon was a milk tester for the Maine Dairy Herd Improvement Association. He visited farms in Cumberland County once a month and tested their milk for butterfat content. He stayed at that job for 20 years before a heart attack forced his retirement in 1965.

A longtime independent agent for life and casualty insurance, Mr. Harmon sold policies out of hishome on Route 35 two miles west of Standish Village. At first he was with Farm Bureau Insurance Co., and he sold policies mostly to farmers. Later that company began to offer life insurance and other policies and changed its name to Concord General Insurance Co.

For many years Mr. Harmon held a third job, as a salesman for Knapp Shoe Co. During the summer he also coached Little League baseball for many years.

"He'd come home and wouldn't even have time for supper," said his wife. "So I'd wrap it up and bring it over to the ballfield."

Born in Standish, a son of Andrew and Eva Hamlin Harmon, he graduated from Westbrook High School. He worked several years for S.D. Warren Co. in Westbrook before joining the Army Air Forces.

He married Mrs. Harmon in 1949, and they moved into

the home on Route 35 the same year.

Mr. Harmon was a treasurer and sang in the choir of the Buxton United Methodist Church. He was a member of the Standish Masonic Lodge and a life member of the Hiram Veterans of Foreign Wars. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, reading and vegetable gardening.
