(Knights of the York Cross of Honor), P.O.A. (Past Officers Association), and the Shrine Anah Temple. Winfield was actively involved in the reconstruction of the Masonic Lodge in Calais. He was a member of St. Croix Bowling Club and loved the sport of baseball. He

was more than 28 years and was Calais Little League. He was a member of Chesley's Auctions and numerous yard sales in Calais. He was a member of the AR and attended races in New York and enjoyed ice fishing and many sporting events. Winfield was actively missed by his family and friends, Beau Harmon; his only two special grandchildren, Marilyn Sotirelis and her husband, William C., of Portland, N.H., and Marilyn Ann Harmon, N.C.; a great-nephew, Colin Harmon and wife, Arlene, of Calais; his husband, Purcell, of Poland. Norway, Sept. 17—Ira Harriman, 87, for several years a prominent dairy farmer on Fore Street until 20 years ago, died suddenly at his home this afternoon. Mr. Harriman was a native of Chatham, N. H., the son of Amos and Elizabeth Johnson Harriman, and he attended the schools of that town until the death of his father in the Civil War. He then came to Paris and lived with the family of Peter Holden, and later went to Greenwood, where he operated a farm. A residence in Aroostook County followed.
