

KENNEBUNKPORT - William Carter Harris, 93, a resident of Ross Road, died Wednesday at Kennebunk Nursing Center following a lengthy illness.

He was born in Manchester, Conn., a son of William W. and Sarah H. Carter Harris. He graduated from South Manchester High School in the Class of 1922 beiore going to Norwich University in Northfield, Vt. He graduated in 1926 with a bachelor's degree in electrical engineering.

He was also a Second Lieutenant in the Cavalry Reserve.

Mr. Harris was a senior member of the U.S. Power Squadrons of Marblehead, Mass. He served in the Coast Guard Auxiliary and was a veteran of World War II, serving in the Air Force Material Command from 1942 to 1946. Ilé remained in the Air Force Reserve following the war, retiring as lieutenant colonel in 1963.

Mr. Harris was employed by General Electric, Riverworks in Lynn, Mass., as an assistant manager of wage rates before transferring to Schenectady, N.Y., then

Valley Forge, Pa., in the Missile and Space Vehicle department, retiring in 1964.

After retiring, Mr. Harris moved to Konnebunkgort. He served as Shade Tree Warden for the lown and was instrumental in saving the elm tree from destruction, earning the nichname "Mr. Tree." In 1986 he was named Arborist of the Vear by the Maine Arborist Association for his part in controlling the Dutch Elm disease.

Mr. Harris served as trustee and chairman of the board for the Kennebunkport Historical Society, Louis T. Graves Memoral Library, South Congregational Church and the Central Board. He served as two-term president for the Kennebunkport Men's Club and was a member of the Arundel Colf Club.

He was a member of the DewittClinton Lodge of Masons in Northfield, VL, the Philanthropic Lodge of Masons of Marohenad, Mass, and the Arundel Lodge of Masons #76 of Kennebunkport. He was also a member of the Salisbury (N.H.) Historical Society and River Tree Arts in Kennebunk.

He was a member of First Church of Christ Congregational in Lynn, Mass., and also was an attendant at South Congregational Church in Kennebunkport. He enjoyed bird-dog hunting and golfing.

His wife, Gladys Hatch Harris, died in 1984.

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Surviving are a daughter, Gracier Harris Snyder of Salisbury, N.H., two grandsons, Evan S. Snyder of Benlomond. Calif. and Jonathan H. Snyder of San Rafael, Calif., and a great-grandson.

He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Lorraine Laney Harris of Augusta; two daughters, Susan Blake of Gardiner and Gail Harris of Waterville; a sister, Mrs. Norman (Nancy) Ouellette of Canaan; two grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and several nephews, nieces and cousins.
