Mr. Hart had worked as a master mariner until retiring in 1974 after 52 years of service. He worked as a captain for the Chester Ferry Co. for 20 years and had made more than 200,000 crossings on the Chester-Bridgeport Ferry. He was a pilot, mate and relief captain for five years on the old Wilson Line excursion boats.

During World War II he was a trial and delivery captain for American Car & Foundry Co., helping to test and deliver crafts built for the British and U.S. navies. Mr. Hart sailed on the Delaware River and made trips to Brazil, Venezuela and many Central American countries.

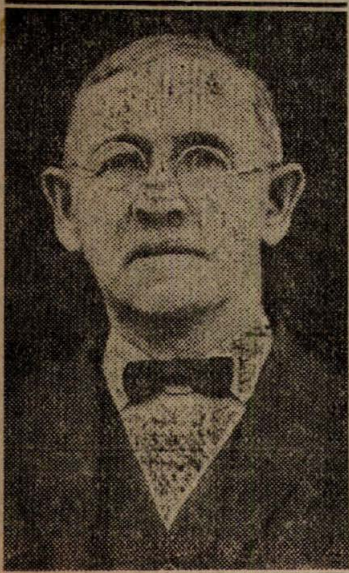

Boothbay Harbor March 3—Funeral services for Herman Hartung, 80, one of the town's oldest business men, were held Thursday afternoon at his home on Atlantic Avenue, the Rev. Elton K. Bassett, pastor of the Congregational Church, officiating.

Born in Manchester, Mr. Hartung came to this town when a young man as superintendent of the Cumberland Bone Phosphate Company. He held the position of superintendent until 1901, when he resigned and formed the Pierce-Hartung Company with the late Paul G. Pierce.

Mr. Hartung was a friend to the needy and many a ton of coal or a box of groceries have found their way to those in poor circumstances through the medium of Mr. Hartung's tender heart. Mr. Hartung was modest about his charities and in many cases the recipient did not know the source from which the articles came.

Mr. Hartung married Miss Amelia G. Torrence of Fairfield in 1875 and they celebrated their golden wedding in 1925. Mrs. Hartung died a few years ago.

He was a member of the Pentecost Lodge of Masons, Pythian Sisters, Eastern Star, Civic Club and was one of the founders of the local lodge of Knights of Pythias.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Victor Gott of Brunswick and Mrs. Neil Due of Westbrook; one son, Clifton E. Hartung of Boothbay Harbor; and five grandchildren.
