Waldo E. "Wally" Harwood Jr., a former hand leader and world traveler who loved the Boston Red Sox, died Wednesday. He was 91.

"He was a man of many, many talents, and he certainly had a zest for life," his wrie, Sylvia Rowell Harwood, recalled Thursday.

His talents were varied, and he

enjoyed three careers. His first career was as a musician.

In 1931, after graduating with distinction from the University of Maine, where he was a member of the Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity and a constant presence on the Dean's list. He led a group of musicians from the college on a four of Italy.

Two years later, he returned to

Italy with his own band, Wally Harwood and his Troubadours. The band played a month at the Club Casanova in Venice, another month at the Hotel Brunnette in Bologna, two days at the Cale Balla in Reggio and two weeks in the Grand Hotel at Riccone.

In Venice, Hoagy Carmichael, who wrote "Stardust," sat in with the band, and autographed Mr. Harwood's arrangement, writing,

In 1940, he was appointed music director. He stayed in the job until 1949. He also played in the stage band of the Civic

Theater during the vaudeville era. He also played the Ricker Gardens, Riverside Ballroom and the Pier and Palace in Old Orchard Beach. "He loved when he used to not at the old pier." his son, Waldo Harwood III, said.

"It started because I was trying to learn how." his wife said. "He certainly helped me make the patterns. The next thing I knew, he was making the clothes. And our daughter's clothes. too ... He did make most of my wardrobe." He made shurs for his son, as well.

Mr. Harwood was as comfortable in a wood shop as he was behind a sewing machine, and just recently finished building a new birdhouse.

As a young man, he was an excellent athlete, lettering in foothail, baseball, basketball and hockey at Deering High School, Mr. Harwood was his Little League coach, and Mr. Harwood taught his children how to play music

Even as an octogenarian, Mr. Harwood was active. He loved his summer home on Sebago Lake, and sailed into his 80s. He also enjoyed fishing and going to Jackman.

He was born in Attleborn, Mass., a son of W. Earle and Ruby Core Harwood.

He was a life member of the musicians union. Chandiers Band, Cornerstone Lodge, Scottish Rites and the Korn Temple, where he played fatte in the concert band and tenor saxophone in the 18-piece dance band. He also wrote arrangements for tunes of the 1300s and 1940s for "Notatisk Nice" dances.

Surviving are his wife of 60 years of Portland, his son, Waldo Harwood III of Portland, a daughter, Nancy Harwood of Portland, two grandchildren, both of Portland, ard a great-grandson of Portland.

DR. ALFRED W. HASKELL

Dr. Alfred W. Haskell, 81, of 142 High St., former director of the Maine Institution for the Blind, died last night.

Dr. Haskell was one of Portland's earliest medical eye specialists. He was widely known in this field throughout Maine and had a distinguished record in eye surgery in army hospitals in France during World War I. He remained active in the Medical Officers Reserve Corps, achieving the rank of major in 1924.




Deer Isle, Dec. 26.—Edvar W. Haskell, 71, well known merchant in this community, died suddenly here Tuesday.
