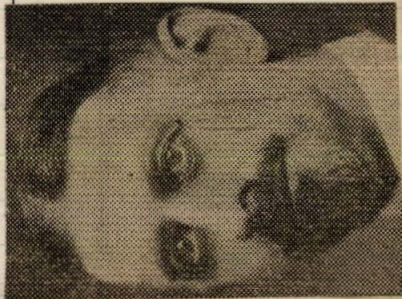

Frank H. Haskell, 74, of 102 Pleasant Avenue, practicing attorney here for 46 years, active many years in Democratic politics and at one time prominent in lodge affairs, died Wednesday night in the Maine General Hospital. He was taken ill soon after his return last Thursday from the American Bar Association convention at Cincinnati, which he had attended as a delegate.

Born at Windham July 1, 1871, Mr. Haskell was graduated from Bridgton Academy in 1890, and Bowdoin College, 1895. He then taught two years at Arlington, Mass., and at North Windham. In 1899 he was admitted to practice in the Cumberland County Court, beginning his practice that year in this City. He was admitted to practice in the U. S. Supreme Court in 1921.

Continuing his residence for some years in his native town, he served as tax collector and on the School Board, and in 1901-02 was a member of the Maine House of Representatives from the class towns of Windham and Pownal.

An ardent Democrat, Mr. Haskell served many years in the councils of his party, and in 1920 was a delegate to the Democratic National Convention at San Francisco. In 1930 he was the party's nominee for United States Senator, receiving 56,559 votes to Senator Wallace H. White's 38,262.

He had conducted a general law practice here, continuing to the time of his death. He served as counsel for the Portland Water District in its proceedings in taking over the system from the former Portland Water Company in 1908.

He was a past grand chancellor of the Grand Lodge of Maine, Knights of Pythias, in 1922-23; a past master of Presumpscot Lodge, AF&AM, at North Windham, a member of Mt. Vernon Chapter, Portland Council,

and of the Eastern Star, and was formerly a member of the Elks. He married Miss Martha W. Howe at Fryeburg in 1901, and she survives him with his sister, Mrs. Alta Cook, of Gray, and several nieces and nephews.

East Windham, Dec. 10—Fred L. Haskell, 73, widely-known Windham resident and long prominent in town affairs both here and at Cumberland, died suddenly today at his home a short time after he had returned from a visit at the town offices at Windham Center. Death was due to embolism.

He was born at New Gloucester, the son of Charles H. and Hannah Libby Haskell, the family moving to Windham when he was two years old. He received his education at Bridgton Academy and in early life bought a farm at Cumberland, where he was for six years a member of the board of selectmen and three years a member of the school board. Returning to Windham he occupied the old home place of his grandfather, and for 15 years he served on the school board, resigning last year.

Mr. Haskell was the first president of the Windham Kiwanis Club, was president of the Cumberland Farmers' Club for seven years, was a charter member of Falmouth Grange and also affiliated with the National Grange. He was a member of Presumpscot Lodge of Masons and of Evangeline Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star.

He leaves a widow, Mrs. Emma Allen Haskell; a son, Walter E.; a daughter, Winifred A.; a brother, Frank H. Haskell, Portland attorney, and a sister, Alta G. Cook of Portland.

Mr. Haskell played with House Four, Italian Heritage Band, Joe Romano Band, S.D. Warren Band, Chandler's Band, the German Hoffbrau Band and the Presumpscot River Bottom Boys. This last group traveled to Europe and played at the Bush compound in Kennebunkport.

"Miles was a top clarinet player and his idol was Benny Goodman," Kelley said. He was "one of the best around here that I ever heard."

Mr. Haskell taught his grandsons, Jeremy and Nicholas, to play on his old clarinets. Jeremy Bowie-Haskell remembers bringing lawn chairs and dinner to listen to his grandfather's bands play in the gazebo at Mill Creek Park in South Portland.

Mr. Haskell loved listening to his music collection, in particular classical jazz, his grandson said.

He also was known for beautiful vegetable gardens, and used to have raspberry and blueberry bushes in his backyard. "He'd take us out to pick from them when we were little," said Jeremy Bowie-Haskell. He made jam and sold the berries from his front porch.

Mr. Haskell was a deacon of the First Congregational Church of South Portland and a member of the Eskimo Club.

He was a member of the Longfellow Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star, of which he was a past grand patron; Hiram Lodge of Masons; Scottish Rite Bodies; and Portland Commandery, Kora Shrine; and was a past commander of the Stewart Morrill American Legion.

His wife, Stamatina Nina Haskell, died in 1986.

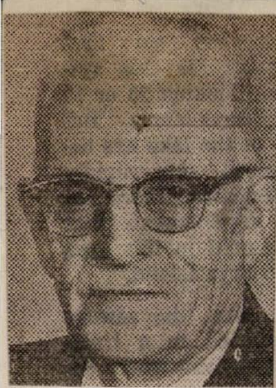

Following his graduation in 1931 from Portland High School, he joined the Civilian Conservation Corps and was stationed at a camp on the Wild River in Gilead. "They used to clean out campgrounds, clear away trees and build roadways," said his wife.

Later he worked in some Lewiston shoe shops before joining the Army in 1942. He was a military policeman stationed in Atlantic City, N.J., and Pensacola, Fla.

He was in the trucking business after the war with his brother-in-law, Eric Dickinson, before going to work for the railroad.

He was a 32nd-degree Mason and a member of the Solar Lodge of Masons in Bath, as well as many other Masonic organizations. He served as president of the Bath High School Alumni Association and was a member of the Woodfords Club of Portland. He coached Little League and Babe Ruth baseball teams.

"He got involved in these groups, and that was his hobby," said his wife, Mary. "He threw himself into everything he did."

Mr. Haskell and his wife spent summers in Westport, next door to the Watson family. Watson said he and Mr. Haskell built the two cottages. They also went mackerel fishing, boating and swimming together.

Mr. Haskell was the son of Robert H. and Margery Chapman Haskell. He graduated from Morse High School in 1932 and married Mary Kenney Aug. 31, 1940.

"He was good at acting and directing, and he did some backstage work too," said Albert Thompson, a former member of the Thespians.

Mr. Haskell served as the group's business manager and president. He had the lead in "Angel Street" and directed a number of its productions, including "The Man Who Came to Dinner," "Born Yesterday," "Yes, My Darling Daughter," and "Buy Me Blue Ribbons."

In addition to his wife, he is survived by two brothers, Roswell C. Haskell of Camden and Philip A.
