BANGOR — Stuart P. Haskell Sr., 90, husband of Charlotte (Lowell) Haskell, died Nov. 10, 1992, in Bangor. He was born in Steuben, March 8, 1902, the son of Charles and Nellie (Cummings) Haskell. He graduated from Jerome High School, Jerome, Idaho. He received a B.S. and Ed.M. degree from the University of Maine. Stuart also studied at the University of Connecticut. He was principal of schools in Essex and Hampton, Conn. Stuart was also principal of schools in Lincoln, Medway, Sullivan and Brewer. He was superintendent of schools in East Corinth, Milford, Lincoln and Winterport. Stuart taught at Island Falls and Ricker Classical Institute of Houlton. Haskell Jr. and his wife Gloria, of Stillwater; a grandson, Christopher Haskell of Saco; three granddaughters, Catherine Haskell of Orono, Caren Ford of Stillwater and Carol Wertz of Old Orchard Beach; six great-grandchildren; one sister, Marion Haskell Thurston of Steuben; one brother, Carl Haskell of Steuben; several nieces and nephews. Special Despatch to Sunday Telegram

Lewiston, Dec. 14 — Dr. William Langdon Haskell, 70, widely-known Lewiston physician and surgeon, died early Monday at his Pine Street home, here, following a three weeks' illness. The son of Woodbury and Arabella Hillman Haskell, he was born at Bowdoinham, Feb. 3, 1870.

For the past three years Dr. Haskell had been a director of the staff of Ste. Marie's General Hospital, where he had been a surgeon since 1903. He was educated in the schools of Brunswick and was graduated from Bowdoin College Medical school in 1894. He later studied in New York. He first started medical practice at Sullivan, where he remained eight years. He then spent a year at Maine General Hospital, Portland, and then came to Lewiston.

In 1900, Dr. Haskell married Miss Emma F. Vose. They have one son, William L. Haskell, Jr., and a grandson, William L. Haskell, 3.

Dr. Haskell was long prominent in the National Guard, first joining when he was 18 years of age. He was made a major when the United States went to war. In March, 1918 he sailed for France where he was assigned to a medical camp at Hausimont, near the front lines.

Returning a year later, he resumed his medical and surgical practice here.
