Fryeburg, April 29—Edward Ellis Hastings, 82, retired member of the law firm of Hastings and Son, died here Wednesday afternoon, following a long decline. The funeral was conducted Saturday afternoon at the residence, the Rev. Wilfred G. Rice, pastor of the Church of the New Jerusalem, and the Rev. Wesley U. Riedel, pastor of the Congregational Church, officiating. The Masonic committal service was conducted at Pine Grove Cemetery, where burial was in the family lot. Honorary pall bearers were Ezra W. Bosworth, A. O. Pike, 2nd, F. A. Hill, E. O. La Casce, E. L. Skillings and A. D. Merrill.

Mr. Hastings, son of David R. Hastings, also an attorney, was born in Lovell, but moved to Lovell with his parents at the age of five years. He attended Bridgton Academy, Bowdoin College and Boston Law School and became his father's partner in the firm then established as Hastings and Son. He practiced 54 years, in due time taking his son, Hugh W. Hastings as his partner, retiring from the firm Jan. 1, 1934.

Mr. Hastings was admitted to the bar in 1879 in Fryeburg, the Supreme Court holding its sessions here at that time in the second Oxford House, which was later burned. Judge William Virgin presided.

## HENRY H. HASTINGS

BETHEL — Henry H. Hastings, 49, a well-known local attorney, died unexpectedly here Sunday at his home.

Mr. Hastings was a former Oxford County Attorney, former municipal court justice at Norway, and at the time of his death was a candidate for the office of Oxford County Attorney in the November elections.

Born in Bethel on Oct. 13, 1918, he was the son of the late Henry H. Hastings, also an attorney, and Ethel Richardson Hastings. He was a graduate of

Gould Academy, Bethel; a member of the class of 1941 at Bowdoin College; and a 1944 graduate of Boston University Law School. He was admitted to Maine, Massachusetts and Federal Court practices following law school graduation, and started his law practice at Bethel in 1946.

Mr. Hastings had served as county attorney from 1953 through 1956. In 1960, he was appointed to serve as judge of the Norway Municipal Court, a duty he continued through 1965 when the new District Court system closed the Norway court.

He was a past president and member of the Oxford County Bar Association and a member of the Maine Bar. In addition, Mr. Hastings was a member of West Parish Church of Bethel, Bethel Lodge No. 97, AF and AM, Kora Temple Shrine of Auburn, and a number of other local groups and Masonic orders.

He was also president of the Bethel Area Development Corp. and a trustee of the Bethel Savings Bank.

Mr. Hastings is survived by his widow, the former Annie MacKinnon of Mexico; a son, Stephen; and a daughter, Cynthia, all of Bethel.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow from the West Parish Congregational Church, the Rev. Clifford Laws officiating. Interment will be in Riverside Cemetery here.

**FRYEBURG — Judge Hugh W. Hastings, 76, died unexpectedly Thursday at his 7 Elm St. home.**

He was born here March 12, 1890, son of Edward E. and Jennie Warren Hastings.

He graduated from Fryeburg Academy in 1907 and from Bowdoin College in 1911. He was a 1914 graduate of Harvard University Law School.

At Bowdoin, he was an outstanding athlete, a guard on the football team and an all-state selection on the track team. He established a hammer throwing record which stood for many years.

Upon graduation from Harvard, he joined his father, Edward E. Hastings, a practicing lawyer here. The law firm had been established by his grandfather, David R. Hastings, shortly before the Civil War.

Upon the death of his father in 1937, he continued to practice alone until joined by his sons David and Peter in 1949 and 1960 respectively.

He served two terms as county attorney in Oxford County, from 1923 to 1927 and as judge of the Western Oxford Municipal Court from 1945 to 1966.

Judge Hastings had been a trustee of Fryeburg Academy 40 years and treasurer of the board since 1932.

During World War I, as a captain in Co. 1, 56th Pioneer Infantry, he served overseas before the Armistice and in the Army of Occupation. He had assembled his own company locally.

**Yarmouth, July 13**—Funeral services will be held Monday for Charles P. Hatch, 77, who rose from a farm boy to bank president, state official and auditor for a international Maine concern.

Mr. Hatch died suddenly Thursday night in his home, 19 Main Street.

Born in Lyman, Dec. 25, 1868, son of Elijah and Frances Kane Hatch, he attended the schools of Whitefield and worked on a farm as a boy. At the age of 15 he entered the office of Dennis A. Meaher in Portland to study law, attended night school and later Shaw's Business College for stenography and business subjects.

Three years later Mr. Hatch became cashier and bookkeeper for the Maine Mutual Accident Association, thus beginning a business and financial career that carried him in successive steps to assistant state bank examiner with offices at Buckfield in 1889; national bank examiner for Maine in 1893 and auditor and accountant for the International Paper Company in New York City in 1903.

Mr. Hatch was Maine's first state auditor in 1907, organizing the office following its creation by the Legislature. In 1914 he became first president of the Forest City Trust Company of Portland, one of many banks to be absorbed by the old Fidelity Trust Company. At one time he was vice president and treasurer of the Merrill Trust Company at Bangor. He organized the Dexter Trust & Banking Company in 1911, and merged two other banks into it.

Mr. Hatch was a member of Evening Star Lodge of Masons at Buckfield; Mount Vernon Chapter, Portland Council and Portland Commandery, Knights Templar; Maine Consistory, 32nd Degree, and of Kora Shrine, Lewiston. He was also a member of the Maine Society of New York and the Underwriters Club of New York.

The only near relative surviving is a son, Charles S. Hatch, seaman 2/c, USN, stationed at Quonset Point, R. I. Funeral services will be held at 2.30 p. m. at the Lindquist Funeral Home. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery, Portland.
