Brig. Gen. John Weston Healy (retired) of the Maine National Guard, former chief of the Maine State Police, died suddenly early Wednesday morning at his home at 115 Sewall Street. He was 64 years old.

He entered military service as a private in the Maine National Guard and retired as a brigadier general in 1944 after 41 years of service. He was an operations officer in the adjutant general's department.

General Healy saw service on the Mexican Border in 1916, commanded Company E from Skowhegan in the first world war and in World War II he transferred from the 43rd Division to Internal Securities, Fifth Service Command in Florida, where he was commended by Gov. Holland of Florida and the commanding general of the Fourth Corps area for his work in Internal Securities.

Just before World War II broke out, he served as Chief of the Maine State Police. He was a selectman at Madison at one time, served as sheriff of Somerset County and was State Superintendent of Public Buildings under ex-Gov. Tudor Gardiner.

He was the first post commander of the Peters-Shortier American Legion Post in Skowhegan, a member of the Fitzgerald-Cummings American Legion Post of Augusta, and a member of the 43rd Infantry Division, Veterans Association. He was also a member of the Euclid Lodge No. 194, F. and A. M., of Madison, De Molay Commandery No. 10, Knights Templar of Skow-

hegan, Somerset Chapter No. 15 of Skowhegan and an honorary and life member of the Somerset Chapter, OES.

General Healy was born July 13, 1886 at Lexington Plantation, the son of Edgely and Florence Weston Healy.

He is survived by his widow, Mrs. Lelia Wyman Healy of Augusta; two sons, Richard Wyman Healy, a major in the regular Army, stationed at Heidelberg, Germany, with the EUCOM Forces, and Robert Morris Healy, a captain in the Marines, stationed at Quantico, Va.; one daughter, Mrs. Althea Chapman of Burlington, Vt.; two nephews, Elroy and John Stanton of Florence, Mass., and nine grandchildren.

AUBURN BASEBALL FAN DIES WHILE WATCHING BOARD

E. M. Heath Prominent in Business Circles

AUBURN, Oct. 10. (Special).—Elton Monroe Heath, known to hundreds of his friends as "Beech" Heath, was stricken with heart failure while watching the score board of the baseball games yesterday, and died before he could be removed to the hospital.

Mr. Heath, one of the best known and best liked citizens of Auburn, was about 70 years old. He was a native of Calais; had resided in Auburn for about 45 years, and had been engaged in business both in this city and in Lewiston.
