THOMASTON — Donald Chalmers Herrick, 93, a storekeeper who was later a bridge tollkeeper, died Monday at a Camden health care facility after a long illness.

For many years, Mr. Herrick owned and operated Herrick's Grocery Store at Green and South Chestnut streets in Augusta. He worked first for his father before taking over the longtime family business.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

"He had a little bit of everything," said his daughter, Emily Herrick. "Meats, candy. It was a general store, with pickles in a barrel and all that sort of stuff."

Mr. Herrick enjoyed tending the counter, his daughter said. "I think he liked the people, and just being in business for himself," she said.

In 1957, business fell off dramatically, and Mr.

Herrick had to close the store.

"The A&P came in a block away," said his daughter. "It kind of took over. It was too much for a small businessman."

Mr. Herrick was an Army veteran of World War II. He was 39 when he joined, the oldest recruit in the Augusta area, and he closed his store during the time he was in the Army. "He went initially to Fort Devens, Mass., but never saw any action overseas," Emily Herrick said.

During the early 1960s, Mr. Herrick was a tolltaker on the Memorial Bridge in Augusta. That bridge's tolls were eliminated in 1967.

Mr. Herrick moved from Augusta to Thomaston about 1960, and his last job was as a clerk at the Maine State Liquor Store in Rockland, where he retired around 1973.

He was a 50-year member of the Augusta Lodge of Masons. He was junior warden and assistant treasurer and member of the Episcopal Church of St. John the Baptist, Thomaston.

He enjoyed photography, woodworking and refinishing furniture.

Born in Augusta, a son of W. Frank and Emily Anderson Herrick, he graduated from Cony High School in Augusta. He married Marion Miller Herrick in 1954, and became a father for the first time at age 53.

Survivors include his wife of Thomaston; and his daughter, Emily Herrick of South China.

A funeral will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday at the Episcopal Church of St. John the Baptist. The Rev. Peter Edwards-Jenks will officiate.
