He worked for the Paragon Button Factory, the Snow Shipyard and National Seafood as an electrician.







Sought by business men here and throughout the State for advice on business and financial matters, he had come to be recognized as the dean of Maine bankers. He had been in failing health, and last week was confined to his home. Sunday he suffered a heart attack, and to-day, after several more attacks,

Was Student Of Shakespeare


His social and cultural interests
also were wide, He was a student

and he liked to speak of Augusta
as the social as well as the political
capital of the state.

It was shortly after the turn of
the century that agitation was organized to move the state house to
Portland, when legislators complained
that there were not sufficient hotel
facilities in Augusta, Mr. Hichborn
headed the Citizens' Committee
which opposed this move, and his
conduct of the affair was credited
for retaining the capitol here.

In 1907 the project of an improved hotel, was undertaken, part
of the program of Augusta to retain
the capital here, Mr. Hichborn was
elected president of the corporation
which built the enlarged Augusta
House corridors, where he devoted
much of his time during legislative
sessions to appearing before various
committees. He served at one time
on the State Board of Charities and
Correction, to which he was appointed
in 1923 by Governor Baxter. In 1924
he was appointed to the Prison Visiting Committee, and during his work
with this committee had the drection

Fison at Thomaston.

He was born Dec. 23, 1857 at Stockton Springs, son of Nathan G. Hichborn, state treasurer from 1863 to
1866. He was educated in the public

In 1965, Mr. Hickey was named assistant superintendent of Westbrook schools. He Mr. Hickey was active in the Pride's Corner Kiwanis Club, for which he was treasurer for many years. He was a member of the Pride's Corner Congregational Church, and had served as a deacon. He also was a Mason in Livermore Falls, and was active in the United Way.

He was born in Livermore Falls, a son of John and Eleanor Dodge Hickey. He graduated from Jay High School, and received a teachers certificate at Farmington State Teachers College. He later earned a master's degree in school administration at the University of Maine and studied school finance and school management programs at Columbia University and the University of Illinois.

During World War II, he served in the Navy in the Atlantic and Pacific theaters.

His daughter remembered that one of his favorite experiences overseas was when he was on a ship transporting German prisoners of war.

"It was Christmas Eve, and he said the German soldiers started to sing 'Silent Night' in German and the Americans sang it in English," Rebecca Hickey said. "He said it really showed that people are people."




