WINDSOR — Elwyn Burleigh Hewett Sr., 65, of Coopers Mills Road, died unexpectedly Friday, Oct. 25, 1996, at Kennebec Valley Medical Center, Augusta Division, Emergency Room.

Winthrop, Oct. 8.—Dr. George W. Hibbs, 45, local dentist, was found with a rifle wound under his chin at his home here this afternoon and died in an ambulance while being taken to Augusta General Hospital.

Medical Examiner L. D. Herring of Augusta, said Dr. Hibbs, a former Bath resident, died of "accidental shooting" but County Attorney James L. Reid ordered an "immediate and complete investigation."

State Trooper Merle Robinson and Deputy Sheriff Arthur Briggs were assigned to the case by Reid, who said the medical examiner had not reported Dr. Hibbs' death to him.

Dr. Herring said he interpreted the shooting as accidental after being called as the man's physician, rather than a medical examiner.

He said the shooting occurred in a spare room over the ell of

the doctor's house where the guns were kept.

His wife, Nellie Sawyer Hibbs, a Winthrop High School teacher, heard the shot and found her husband on the floor. He was taken to Augusta General Hospital in a private ambulance, and pronounced dead on arrival.

Dr. Hibbs was born Nov. 17, 1902 at Hebron the son of Alton and Nellie Sawyer Hibbs.

He has been a resident of this town for two years. He was a lieutenant commander in the Naval Reserves during World War II, giving up his practice in Bath to enlist.

He was a member of the Bucksfield Lodge, F and AM, the Bath Lodge of Elks and the Sagadahoc Rod, Gun and Skeet Association.

He is survived by his parents, widow, a son, Joseph, a student in Winthrop High School and daughter, Judith, of Indiana and two sisters, Mrs. Reginald Roth, of South Portland and Mrs. Earle Webster of Fayette.

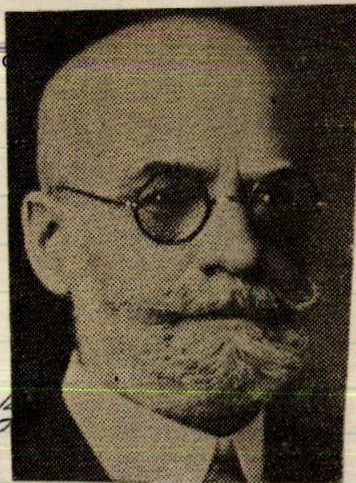

Augusta, Dec. 29—Charles S. Hichborn, 84, president of the First National Granite Bank of Augusta, and leader for many years in Maine and New England banking circles, died today at his home, 66 Winthrop Street. Funeral services will be held at 2 p. m. Thursday in St. Mark's Episcopal Church.

A former mayor of Augusta, active in civic affairs, he was credited largely for retaining the seat of state government in Augusta during the critical years early in the century when an attempt was made to move it to Portland because of lack of hotel facilities here.

Sought by business men here and throughout the State for advice on business and financial matters, he had come to be recognized as the dean of Maine bankers. He had been in failing health, and last week was confined to his home. Sunday he suffered a heart attack, and today, after several more attacks, he succumbed.

Leaders in political and business life immediately recognized the passing of one of the men who had done more to develop the business and cultural life of the capital city. Early every committee organized for the promotion or improvement of an institution in this city bore his name, frequently as chairman, and during the years he been recognized as the man who got things done for Augusta.

Was Student Of Shakespeare

His social and cultural interests also were wide. He was a student of Shakespeare, and only last year, after delivering a lecture on the works of the English playwright at the Augusta Kiwanis Club, he was made an honorary member of the club. He wrote some verse himself, and he liked to speak of Augusta as the social as well as the political capital of the state.

It was shortly after the turn of the century that agitation was organized to move the state house to Portland, when legislators complained that there were not sufficient hotel facilities in Augusta. Mr. Hichborn headed the Citizens' Committee which opposed this move, and his conduct of the affair was credited for retaining the capitol here.

In 1907 the project of an improved hotel, was undertaken, part of the program of Augusta to retain the capital here. Mr. Hichborn was elected president of the corporation which built the enlarged Augusta House. In 1909, when the task of enlarging the State House was undertaken, Mr. Hichborn was appointed by Governor Fernald as chairman of the Building Commission.

Was Familiar Figure

He was a familiar figure in state house corridors, where he devoted much of his time during legislative sessions to appearing before various committees. He served at one time on the State Board of Charities and Correction, to which he was appointed in 1923 by Governor Baxter. In 1924 he was appointed to the Prison Visiting Committee, and during his work with this committee had the direction of the modernization of the State Prison at Thomaston.

He was born Dec. 23, 1857 at Stockton Springs, son of Nathan G. Hichborn, state treasurer from 1863 to 1866. He was educated in the public schools of Stockton Springs and at Westbrook Seminary, which he served as a trustee for a long period. He came to Augusta in 1880 and entered the employ of the First National Bank, and seven years later was elected cashier, a position he held 25 years.

Following the death of Lendall Titcomb Mr. Hichborn was elected president of the First National Bank. In the Spring of 1916 he also was chosen president of the Granite National Bank. Holding the position of president of both banks until they were consolidated under the name of the

In 1965, Mr. Hickey was named assistant superintendent of Westbrook schools. He

Mr. Hickey was active in the Pride's Corner Kiwanis Club, for which he was treasurer for many years. He was a member of the Pride's Corner Congregational Church, and had served as a deacon. He also was a Mason in Livermore Falls, and was active in the United Way.

He was born in Livermore Falls, a son of John and Eleanor Dodge Hickey. He graduated from Jay High School, and received a teachers certificate at Farmington State Teachers College. He later earned a master's degree in school administration at the University of Maine and studied school finance and school management programs at Columbia University and the University of Illinois.

During World War II, he served in the Navy in the Atlantic and Pacific theaters.

His daughter remembered that one of his favorite experiences overseas was when he was on a ship transporting German prisoners of war.

"It was Christmas Eve, and he said the German soldiers started to sing 'Silent Night' in German and the Americans sang it in English," Rebecca Hickey said. "He said it really showed that people are people."

In addition to his daughter, Mr. Hickey is survived by his wife, Geraldine Day Hickey of Westbrook; two other daughters, Rhonda L. Burden of Steilacoon, Wash., and Raelene H. Bean of Yarmouth; two sisters, Eileen Palmer and Ruth Forbes, both of Jay; and three grandchildren.
