
Mr. Hill had served as organist at several Portland churches and had been a teacher of music in the Greater Portland area for more than 50 years.

Saco until he retired in 1975. He started at the funeral home as a spare driver, and


later did painting and repairs and constructed fancy casket stands and flower stands.







longtime storekeeper in Kennebunk area

KENNEBUNK - Roland P. Hill, 93, of Florence Circle, a local storekeeper for 30 years, died Saturday at the Maine Veterans Home in Scarborough.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Southern Maine, We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He was born in Kennebunk, a son of Willis and Lillian Lord Hill, and attended Kennebunk schools and the University of Maine at Orono.

Mr. Hill studied agriculture at the university but never pursued farming, said his wife of 49 years, Lena M. Garnett Hill. He purchased the Hills News Agency store in the late 1920s and staved in the business until his retirement in 1957.

Mr. Hill had a soda fountain at the store. located on Main Street in

Kennebunk. He sold newspapers and periodicals as well as guns and fishing and hunting supplies. In 1935, Mr. Hill opened the Arundel Market on Route 1 in Arundel. His wife said he employed about 14 people between the two stores.

She described Mr. Hill as a witty, outgoing man. "I know when he was in the stores the salesmen always liked to stop and talk to Roland because they had fun with him," she said.

Mr. Hill enjoyed hunting and fishing and had been a sports guide in the 1920s and '30s. "He had a cottage at Sebago Lake and took parties down there for salmon and trout fishing," his wife said.

He guided bird and deer hunters and on several occasions guided Kenneth Roberts, a Maine author of historical novels who won a special Pulitzer Prize

citation for his work

"Kenneth Roberts considered Roland a friend as well as a guide. I have given the Brick Store Museum (in Kennebunk) at least 10 of his books, autographed to Roland and signed Kenneth Roberts," his wife said.

Mr. Hill was a World War II Navy veteran, who entered the service at age 43 and spent two years, four months and 22 days stationed in Portland, his wife said.

"He went in as a 2nd class storekeeper and went to 1st class but they kept him in the pay office the whole time. He went aboard the submarines when they came into port and paid the servicemen," she said.
