Dr. Francis O. Hill Dies At Monticello

Special Despatch to The Press Herald

Monticello, Jan. 2—Dr. Francis O. Hill, 64, Monticello medical practitioner for 38 years and one of the State's outstanding physicians, died of a heart attack early this morning after a brief illness. Four years ago he suffered a shock, from which he had not fully recovered. Born at Newburg, son of Mr. and Mrs. John J. Hill he moved to Mars Hill with his parents in 1885. He was graduated from Bucksport Seminary in 1892, and Bowdoin Medical School in 1899. Following graduation he worked with his uncle, Dr. F. O. K. S. Hill in Brewer for one year, coming here in 1900, when he married Miss Mary Jane Landers of Mars Hill.

A member of the Maine Medical Association and American Medical Association, he was during the World War a member of the Maine Medical Advisory Board. He represented Monticello in the State Legislature in 1907.

He was a member of the Monument Lodge of Masons at Houlton, Kora Temple Mystic Shrine of Lewiston and the Independent Order of Foresters. He leaves his wife; a daughter, Mrs. Ione Ketchum of

Bridgewater; a son, Montford of Monticello; a brother, the Rev. Montford Hill of Millinocket; and a sister, Mrs. Winnie M. Colbath of Bangor. A private Masonic funeral will be held at the home at 2 p. m. Wednesday.

Bath, Feb. 2—Fred D. Hill, 74, a past president of the Maine Bankers' Association, who retired last July 1 after 50 years' service with the Bath National Bank, died tonight at his home following a long illness.

Born in Bath, a son of William Dayton and Cordelia Morrison Hill, he was educated at Bath schools and upon his graduation from the old Bath High School in 1885 entered Eastman's Business College at Poughkeepsie, N. Y.

From business college he returned to Maine to enter the employ of the Maine Central Railroad in the company's Portland office. In 1891 he became assistant cashier of the Bath National Bank, of which his father was cashier. At the time he began his long service with the bank it was in the old Bank Block, now occupied by the Woolworth store.

Upon the death in 1893 of his father, who had been cashier since 1865, Mr. Hill became cashier and held the office until ill health forced his resignation in 1941. He was also a director and vice president of the bank, having been elected to these offices in 1930.

Mr. Hill's father served Dunlap Commandery, Knights Templar, as treasurer for 20 years and Mr. Hill in 1928 ended his 20th year as treasurer of another local masonic group, Solar Lodge. He was also for many years master of the exchequer of Acadia Lodge, Knights of Pythias. Long a member of Grace Episcopal Church, Mr. Hill served as both senior and junior warden for long periods and had been a vestryman for more than 30 years.

He was a past president and one of the five surviving charter members of the Bath Rotary Club, a past president of the Bath YMCA, and belonged to the old Kennebec Yacht

Dr. George E. Hill, 69, for 35 years a practicing dentist in Portland and a lifelong resident of Cape Elizabeth, died Friday afternoon in his home on Ocean House Road, Cape Elizabeth, after a long illness. He retired from active practice six years ago because of poor health.

Kennebunk. He sold newspapers and periodicals as well as guns and fishing and hunting supplies. In 1935, Mr. Hill opened the Arundel Market on Route 1 in Arundel. His wife said he employed about 14 people between the two stores.

She described Mr. Hill as a witty, outgoing man. "I know when he was in the stores the salesmen always liked to stop and talk to Roland because they had fun with him," she said.

Mr. Hill enjoyed hunting and fishing and had been a sports guide in the 1920s and '30s. "He had a cottage at Sebago Lake and took parties down there for salmon and trout fishing," his wife said.

He guided bird and deer hunters and on several occasions guided Kenneth Roberts, a Maine author of historical novels who won a special Pulitzer Prize citation for his work.

"Kenneth Roberts considered Roland a friend as well as a guide. I have given the Brick Store Museum (in Kennebunk) at least 10 of his books, autographed to Roland and signed Kenneth Roberts," his wife said.

Mr. Hill was a World War II Navy veteran, who entered the service at age 43 and spent two years, four months and 22 days stationed in Portland, his wife said.

"He went in as a 2nd class storekeeper and went to 1st class but they kept him in the pay office the whole time. He went aboard the submarines when they came into port and paid the servicemen," she said.

Mr. Hill was a lifetime member of the York Lodge of Masons, Knights of Pythias, Mousam Lodge, Priscilla Chapter of the Order of Eastern Star, and the Royal Arch Masons.

Also surviving are a son, Edward Hogue, and a daughter, Marilyn Cote, both of Kennebunk; 10 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
