Heywood S. Hinds engineer on tugboats, lobsterman

ROUND POND - Heywood S. Hinds, 100, a lifelong mariner and lobsterman, died Sunday at Country Manor Nursing Home at Coopers Mills in Whitefield.

Mr. Heywood first went to sea as a boy aboard his stepfather's old sloop.

"He grew up on the water," said his son, Leroy Hinds of Washington. "He went sailing all the time on the sloop, hand-lining for fish. He used to tell me about how him and another fellow from Round Pond would take that little sloop and anchor in coves at night, and hand-line all day for haddock and ground-fish." He mostly fished out around Monhegan and Matinicus islands.

Mr. Hinds couldn't pass the physical to get into the Army during World War I, so he went to Portland and worked as a machinist on the waterfront. That's where he got interested in tugboats, his son said.

At age 22, he started shipping out on oceangoing tugboats New York Harbor. He worked on several tugs from Boston to New York, including the Wyoming, and most notably the Perth Amboy, which occasionally docked in Rockland, giving him a chance to go home for a night or two.

He retired in 1955 as a chief engineer after 30 years working for the Moran Co., and then worked as a lobster fisherman until retiring again in 1976.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

Mr. Hinds had a great many stories of his years at sea. He told of severe storms, of danger, and some were embellished to be humorous.

"He saw a lot of things in his life," his son said. "He was there when electricity came into Round Pond - and cars, too. He saw all the wars."

For most of his life, Mr. Hinds enjoyed listening to Boston Red Sox games on the radio, and he remembered well their last World Series championship, in 1918, said his son.

Mr. Hinds also used to share a tale of revenge at sea. The captain of the Perth Amboy once fired the first mate, who was of German ancestry. "That man threatened to get even, and eventually went back to Germany," his son said. During World War II, the Germans gave him command of a U-boat. "Knowing that he knew the New England coast, they sent him back here."

That, he used to say, is why the Perth Amboy, while Mr. Hinds was aboard, got shot up by a German U-boat.

Born in Round Pond, a son of Samuel T. and Emma Tarr Hinds, he graduated from Bristol High School.

At age 7, he helped Maine Gov. Bert M. Fernald unveil the memorial statue to his great-grandfather - Commodore Samuel F. Tucker - in Hillside Cemetery in Bremen. Fernald served as governor from 1908-1912.

"I was chosen because I was the only living descendant of Commodore Tucker that they could find," he said in a 1993 story in the Lincoln County News.

Mr. Hinds was a 76-year member of the Bristol Masonic Lodge.

A son, Alired, and a granddaughter, Brenda Hatch, died previously.

Surviving are a son, Leroy of Washington; two granddaughters, Mrs. Bob (Lori) Harris of Damariscotta and Mrs. Jim (Annette) Spear of Washington; a grandson, Lee Hinds of Chelsea; and seven great-grandchildren.

A memorial service will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at Round Pond United Methodist Church. The Rev. H. Everett Wiswell will officiate. Burial will be announced at a later date by Hall Funeral Home, Waldoboro.

Livermore Falls, June 26—Funeral services for Prince E. Hinds were held Thursday from Brown's funeral home with the Rev. F. Stuart Kinely of the Livermore Falls Baptist Church officiating. The bearers from Oriental Star Lodge, of which Mr. Hinds was the oldest member, were Samuel Coolidge, John Coolidge, Carlton Bailey, and Charles Hull. Norland Grange, of which he was an honorary member, attended in a body. Burial was in Pleasant View Cemetery.

Prince E. Hinds died as the result of a fall. He was born at Livermore, April 11, 1848, the son of Stephen and Mary Eastman Hinds. Following his graduation from Wilton Academy he taught school at Livermore and Farmington. He married Miss Susie Wyman of East Livermore, and they lived in Wilton for some time.

Later he moved to Boston where Mr. Hinds was a wholesale fruit and produce commission merchant. Upon his retirement he returned to Maine, following his wife's death.

His second wife was Miss Claribel Jordan of Boston, whom he married in 1914. She died in 1924. Survivors include the three children of his first marriage, Mrs. Ethel Hinds Sherman of Liberty; two sons, Almon of Detroit, Mich., and Owen of East Livermore.

Franklin G. Hinckley partner in Portland law firm

BREWER — Franklin G. Hinckley, 85, a longtime Portland attorney who served on Maine's board of bar overseers and who was involved in a wide array of community organizations and services in Cumberland County, died Saturday at a Bangor health care center.

Mr. Hinckley became an associate with Bradley, Lunnell, Nulty and Brown in 1943 and a was named a partner in 1946. The firm would later become known as Perkins, Thompson, Hinckley and Keady.

During his long career in practicing law in Maine, Mr. Hinckley served as a member and later chairman of the Maine Supreme Judicial Court Advisory Committee on Rules of Evidence. From 1978-86 he was on the Board of Overseers of the Bar of the State of Maine, and served as board chairman from 1978-80. He retired in December 1989.

Mr. Hinckley had been a member of the Portland Rotary since 1950 and served as its president in 1957. He was Rotary's district governor in 1967, and was historian for the 70th anniversary of the club in 1990.

Mr. Hinckley was a longtime member of the Portland Country Club, and served on its board of governors and as secretary from 1962-85. He was on the board of directors of the Portland YMCA, and the advisory board of the Salvation Army. He was a incorporator of the Maine Medical Center, a member of the Portland Club, Woodlarks Club, Cumberland Club, Fraternity Club, and a director of the Portland Boys' Club. He was a former trustee, vice president and secretary of the Portland Public Library.

In 1965 he was president of the Cumberland County Bar Association, and in 1964 he was chairman of the United Fund of Greater Portland. In 1972 he was honored as the Portland Kiwanis Club's man of the year.

Mr. Hinckley was a past president of the Harvard Club of Western Maine, and a past president of the Harvard Law School Association of Maine. He was a former vetryman at Trinity Episcopal Church in Portland, an active member of the Masons and the Kora Temple Shrine, and a trustee of Westbrook College and North Yarmouth Academy.

He was a 14-year member and former chairman of Portland's Board of Appeals.

Born in Medford, Mass., a son of John William and Olive Lyon Glazier Hinckley, he graduated in 1935 from Harvard College and in 1938 from Harvard Law School.

His wife, Myrna Crane Hinckley, died in 1969. Surviving are a son, Franklin G. Jr. of Brewer and two grandsons, David W. of Old Lyme, Conn., and James G. Hinckley of Brewer.

A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday at Brookings-Smith in Bangor. The Rev. Kristin Orr of St. Patrick's Episcopal Church of Brewer will officiate. A reception will follow at the funeral home. Burial will be in Central Cemetery, Beverly, Mass.

GREEN VALLEY, ARIZ. — Philip Joseph Hinkley, 90, of Green Valley, Ariz. and Falmouth, died April 19, 2002 in Green Valley.

He was born May 26, 1911 on Rochester St., Westbrook, a son of Lillian



Philip J. Hinkley Maine in 1940.

A. (Littlefield) and Edgar R. Hinkley. He grew up in Westbrook, graduating from Westbrook High School in 1929. He then earned a Chemical Engineering degree from the University of

Phil was a member of Kappa Sigma fraternity, a 60-plus year member of Masonic Temple (Warren-Phillips Lodge A.F. & A.M.), and a 55-year member of TAPPL. He worked for S.D. Warren Co. for over 40 years.

He was Superintendent of the Pulp Mill in Muskegon, Mich. for 20 years. While working in the industry, he was responsible for helping develop paper raincoats, waterproof map paper, paper used to repel poison gas, lightweight bazooka tubes for use on aircraft, and other paper products used by the military. During the war, he patrolled the Portland waterfront with the Coast Guard Auxiliary; he was one of seven of the 5000 working at the mill who was designated essential for the war effort and removed from the draft.

After the war, he designed and implemented several new processes for the paper industry which included the first facility for dumping trucks loaded with wood chips, the first plant for producing chlorine dioxide, the first lime kiln, the first plant with a continuous digester, and automation of the pulp mill, which significantly increased production from 150 to 250 tons per day while also reducing staff from over 100 to less than 50. His environmental concerns were progressive for his time, and all the gases from processing were vacuumed into one location and burned to provide hot water.

In 1976, he helped start up the Scott Paper mill in Hinkley. Phil managed to have the plant in operation by New Year's Eve so that the company could take a one-year depreciation on the \$250-million facility.

In 1955, he started the first pulpmill in New Zealand while teaching others how to run the plant which continues in operation today. He traveled around the world during the project.

Phil lived in Maine until 1956 when he moved to North Muskegon, Mich. where he worked and lived until retiring in 1978, and then moved to Green Valley, Ariz.

He was honored at the TAPPL annual meeting in 1993 as a 50-year member. Recently, he was recognized by the University of Maine as an outstanding alumni and awarded the first annual Francis Crowe Society Medallion, an engineering award.

Phil was an avid tennis player, playing until he was 87, and was a member of his high school and university teams. He helped start a tennis/sports center in Muskegon, Mich., helping a number of younger players improve their games while very much enjoying playing tennis with the Sahuarita Boys Tennis Team.

Last summer Phil celebrated his 90th birthday with a party in his honor at the Westbrook-Warren Congregational Church, celebrated his 60th wedding anniversary, and participated in his granddaughter's wedding.

He was predeceased by a brother, Col. Frank R. Hinkley of Decatur, Ga.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, Marian B. (Andrews) Hinkley of Green Valley, Ariz. and Falmouth; a son, F. Edward Hinkley and his wife, Louise of Augusta; a daughter, Susan E. Goldberg and her husband, Saul of Green Valley, Ariz. and Falmouth; and two grandchildren, James M. Hinkley of Green Valley, Ariz., and Christina E. (Mrs. Buddy) Deliberto of Webster, Mass.

Memorial services were held in Arizona. A Maine service will be held at the Westbrook-Warren Congregational Church in Westbrook on May 26th at 1 p.m. Interment will be in Maple Grove Cemetery, Mechanic Falls. Arrangements are by Bring Funeral Home, Tucson, Ariz.

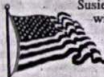

Maine Highway Crashes Kill 2

Motor vehicle crashes involving autos and trucks took the lives of two men in separate Maine localities yesterday.

Woodford Bushey, 34, of Rocky Hill, Conn., was killed and his brother seriously injured when their car and a truck collided on Route 2 at Molunkus, in Aroostook County.
