J. SHERMAN HOAR

AUBURN — J. Sherman Hoar, 80, former restaurant and theater owner, died Saturday morning in a Lewiston hospital. He had lived here since his retirement 14 years ago.

He was born at Rangeley, July 5, 1887, son of Anson M. and Augusta Emily Hinckley Hoar.

After working in his father's grocery business as a youth, Mr. Hoar became engaged in the restaurant business. He owned several theaters and was a pioneer in the state's motion picture industry.

In 1945 he sold his Sherman Theaters at Rangeley, Phillips and Kingfield.

He had served as town manager at Rangeley and also the sealer of weights and measures. He was a justice of the peace until last year.

Mr. Hoar was the author of "The Pioneer Days of Rangeley Lakes, Maine," which he wrote in 1928. He was also a photographer, working as a developer and printer for 35 years.

He was a member of Kemankeag Lodge, AF and AM, Rangeley.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Jane A. Charpentier of Lewiston; a son, Jay of Auburn, and six grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Plummer and Merrill Funeral Home, 212 Turner St. Entombment will be in Mount Auburn Cemetery.

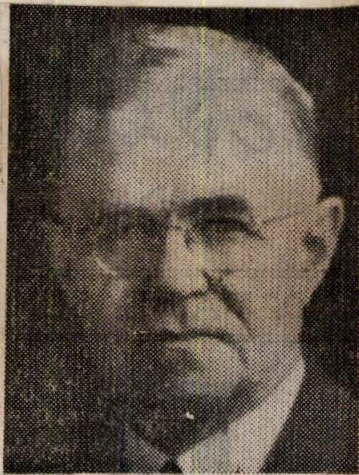

Alfred, March 13.—The death of Frederick Andrews Hobbs, attorney-at-law in Alfred for many years, occurred Wednesday after a long illness, at the home of his father, George Henry Hobbs, Alfred Mills. H.; five grandchildren, Miss Marjorie Merrill, Portsmouth, Mrs. Robert LeBreux and Mrs. Raymond LeBreux, both of Springvale, Frederick R. Hobbs and William K. Hobbs, both of Sanford. There are also four great-grandchildren, Frederick and Richard Hobbs, Sanford, and Linda and Robert LeBreux, Jr., Springvale.

Funeral services were held at Hurd's Funeral Home, Sanford, Saturday, with the Rev. Sumner H. Mitchell of the Sanford Unitarian Church, officiating. Interment was in Evergreen Cemetery, Alfred.

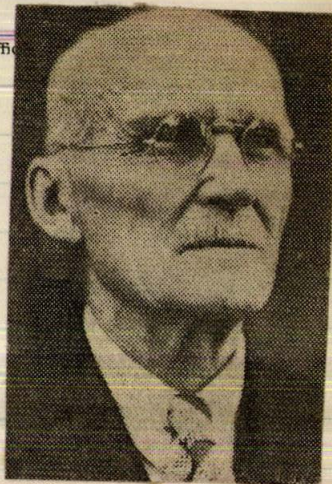

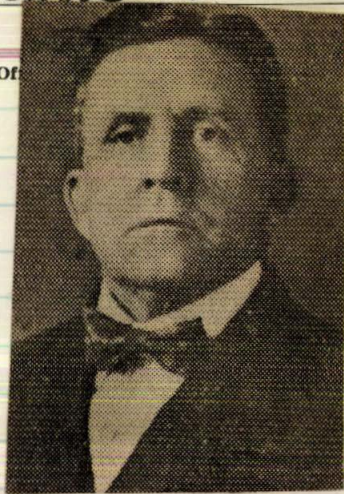
