Mr. Hoffses was on the Republican Town, Knox County and State committees for many years. He was a delegate to the Republican State Convention for 30 years. He served two years in the Maine House of Representatives and nine years in the state Senate, four as assistant majority floor leader. He chaired the Council of State Government for eight years, the Eastern Region Council of State Government and for one year was vice chairman of the National Council of State Government, headquartered in Lexington, Ky.

Mr. Hoffses was predeceased by two wives, Marjorie Taylor Hoffses and Winona Vannah Hoffses.

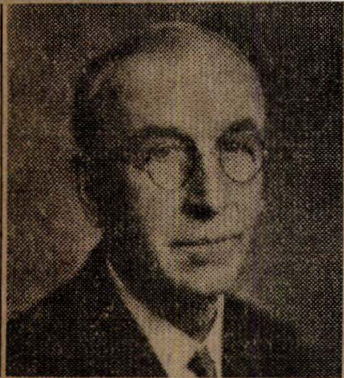

Vanceboro, April 14.—The death of Edward A. Holbrook, 70, occurred late Thursday after several weeks illness. Stricken in early December with a partial paralysis, his condition had gradually improved until about four weeks ago when complications set in from which he did not rally.

Mr. Holbrook was born at Abbotsford, Quebec, the son of the late Elisha T. and Mary Ann Whitney Holbrook. The family moved to Vanceboro in the early days of the Shaw Brothers tannery operations where he was for a time employed as clerk and bookkeeper in their tannery store, later establishing the business which he continued until his death.

He was devoted to the affairs of his home town, having served 23 years as chairman of the Board of Selectmen and one year as second member. In politics he was prominent in the councils of the Republican party, being elected as representative to the Legislature from this district for the years 1927, 1929 and 1931, where he was given important committee assignments and accomplished much for the benefit of the district.

He was married in early life to Louisa C. Sprague, a daughter of the late George M. B. Sprague, prominent in the early development of Vanceboro. Besides Mrs. Holbrook, he is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Harry D. Davis of Vanceboro, Mrs. Lee R. Titcomb of Stratford, Conn., and Miss Ruth C. Holbrook of New York City; one brother, Harry S. Holbrook of Vanceboro and six grand-children.

Mr. Holbrook was a member of Baskahegan Lodge E. and A. M., of Danforth, St. Croix Royal Arch Chapter of Calais; Hugh dePayens Commandery, Knights Templar of Calais and Annah Temple, Mystic Shrine, of Bangor.

Kendrick Holbrook, 76, retired train engineer, 'a people person'

KENNEBUNKPORT — Kendrick Holbrook of Cape Porpoise, a retired locomotive engineer who drove a delivery truck for Port Lobster Co. for 15 years, died Tuesday. He was 76.

Mr. Holbrook worked for the Boston & Maine Railroad, now known as Guilford Rail System, for more than 30 years.

As an engineer, Mr. Holbrook operated the steam-powered locomotives and managed the crew. He was regularly dispatched to locations throughout New England to pick up cars for long and short runs. Each day offered a different experience, said his son Adam Holbrook of South Berwick.

"He loved it. He loved seeing different people," his son said. "He had a sense of humor, and he tried to make work fun. He would go to different coffee shops. He was a people person. It was easy for him."

Mr. Holbrook operated steam engines just before trains transitioned to diesel power. His son said he was a hard worker who was dedicated to the railroad and always came home with great stories. He also had his share of close calls, he said.

"The thing I remember most was kids throwing rocks into the windshield," his son said. "It was a tough life out there. He came home with a lot of great stories about how fantastic it was."

Mr. Holbrook grew up in Biddeford and graduated from Biddeford High School in 1952, he married the former Gloria Hilton. Mr. Holbrook also leaves four children and a stepson.

On Wednesday, Adam Holbrook reflected on the impact his father had had.

"He was a great father. He was real calm," his son said. "He was good at leading you on the path. He

didn't push too hard. He allowed you to fall down, but he was there to help you pick yourself up when you did."

Mr. Holbrook was a member of the Masons Arundel Lodge AF & AM No. 76, the York County Shrine Club and Kora Shriners of Lewiston. He regularly participated in events to help raise money for local and national charitable organizations.

"They watched out for each other," his son said. "It was the community spirit he enjoyed."

In 1989, Mr. Holbrook retired from the railroad. Shortly thereafter, he started working for Port Lobster Co. in Kennebunkport as its delivery driver. He worked there for 15 years. Greg Stuart, the business' manager, said it was fun to have him around.
