Augusta, Aug. 21.—Associate Justice James H. Hudson of the Maine Supreme Judicial Court died at 6.30 a. m. today at the Augusta General Hospital where he had been a patient since Monday. He was 69 years of age and less than a year from retirement.

He was the second member of Maine's higher courts to die in less than three weeks. Superior Court Justice Earle L. Russell of Cape Elizabeth died in Portland Aug. 5.

Justice Hudson, first Piscataquis County attorney to be named to a state court, was appointed justice of the Superior Court in 1929 by Gov. William Tudor Gardiner.

He was born March 21, 1878, the son of Henry, jr., and Ada Lougee Hudson. He was graduated from Coburn Classical Institute in 1896 and prepared for law school at Colby College, where he received his degree in 1900.

Receiving an honorary LLD degree from Colby in 1932, he was named to the Board of Trustees of the college a year later. He was appointed a trustee of the Guilford Trust Company the same year.

For many years he was a member of the Republican State Committee and a member of the State Board of Bar Examiners. He was instrumental in organizing the Piscataquis Valley Country Club and was its first president.

He married Mary Stevens Mc-Kown of Boothbay Harbor Nov. 11, 1903.

He was a Mason, a member of the Knights of Pythias and Knights Templar and the Guilford Chamber of Commerce. He belonged to the Delta Kappa Epsilon, social, and Phi Beta Kappa, honorary, fraternities while in college.

Surviving besides his widow are a daughter, Mrs. John Power, White, and three grandchildren Mary Loantha, James Henr' Hudson and Betsey Louise White


Street Railroad Union.
