Capt. Omar J. Humphrey

Capt., Omar James Humphrey of Yarmouth, Maine and Cloverdale, Cal., died at his California home April 25.

After the Armistice was signed was transferred to the SS West Modus and on October 31, 1919, rescued all passengers and part of crew of the Pacific SS Co., British Steamship Frazilka, wrecked on the rocky shores of Nicobar Island in the Bay of Bengal October 30th. The passengers being transferred to the West Modus without the loss or injury to a single person and landed at Penang Strait Settlements. The captain was awarded a silver cup by the British Government and a Chronometer watch by the owners of the SS Frazilka.

From 1922 to 1928 was in command of the Isthmian Steamship Company's SS Fairfield City and was retired in October having reached the age limit. After his retirement he spent his Summers in Yarmouth at the old home until his brother's death in 1936. He had sailed around the world seven times.

He was a member of Washington Consistory AASR 32rd Valley of Seattle, Orient of Washington; life members of Nile Temple AAON Mystic Shrine of Seattle, Wash., life member of Casco lodge, FAM No. 36, Yarmouth, Maine; life member of San Francisco; life member California Commandary, No. 1 KT San Francisco, Calif.

He is survived by a son, Capt. Omar J. Humphrey Jr., of Seattle, Wash., now in Australia with the armed forces and a daughter, Mrs. Philip A. Wooten of Vancouver, three grandchildren and cousins in Yarmouth, Pittsfield and Newport.

Frederick William Humphreys, 69, for many years active in the insurance business established by his late father, died Thursday at Bath Memorial Hospital after an illness of eight months. A graduate of the old Bath High school in the class of 1901, he had given most of his adult life to the D. M. Humphreys Co., since associating with his father 48 years ago.

# Dr. Allston F. Hunt, 94, Dies In Congress St. Home

After practicing medicine in Swampscott, Mass., several years, he returned to Portland in 1906.

Dr. Hunt was a direct descendant of Sir William Pepperrell of Kittery. His grandfather, Dr. Jacob Hunt, began his Portland practice in 1802.

Since returning here, Dr. Hunt has lived in the stone house his father built in Stroudwater in 1861. Interest-

ed in historical research and geology, he was a life member of the Maine Historical Society. His prize possessions included some of the medical instruments his father and grandfather had used.

Dr. Hunt was a member of Deering Lodge, AF & AM, and the Stroudwater Baptist Church. A staunch Republican, he attended many GOP state conventions.

He never married. Survivors include a nephew, Charles R. Hunt, West Buxton, and five grand nephews, Henry Hunt, South Portland; Robert Hunt, Swampscott, Mass.; Alan Hunt, Nahant, Mass.; and Donald and Richard Hunt, Lynn, Mass.
