FAIRFIELD — John Herbert Hunt, 81, of Fairfield, formerly of Bingham, died quietly from heart failure at his home in the company of his wife and members of his family, Saturday, Jan. 4, 2003. He was born in Hanover, Mass., April 9, 1921, the eldest child of Irving M. and Myrtis (Shepherd) Hunt.

In 1935, the family moved to Fairfield, where his father managed Kennebec Farms for Ransom Kelley. Farming was not his choice of an occupation, however, and after graduating from Lawrence High School of Fairfield in 1939, he attended the University of Maine in pursuit of a bachelor of science degree in wildlife conservation. In January 1943, he interrupted his studies to volunteer for the U.S. Army. He trained at Fort Hood in Texas and Fort Ord in California. He served as commander of amphibian assault tractors under heavy combat conditions in landings and combat in the Solomon Islands, Borneo, and the Philippine Islands. When the war ended, his unit was scheduled to be in the first wave to hit the Japanese beaches.

In 1946, he was discharged from the Army and resumed his academic career at the University of Maine. In that same year, he married Patricia Ann Coleman, with whom he had six children, five of whom survived infancy. He completed his bachelor's degree and did graduate study at the University of Maine before entering the employ of the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, for whom he worked until retirement in 1987.

Over the course of a long career, he was a major contributor to the life of that department, working at many projects that helped define its future direction. He was instrumental in working for management legislation and effective protection of numerous species. His work with beaver management was recognized as a model throughout North America. He was recognized by both his fellow biologists and the trapping community as a man who generally knew what he was talking about, no small achievement. He

shared his knowledge, ideas, and enthusiasm with his younger colleagues, many of whom still work for the department.

He valued common sense in his profession, and his comment that "we don't need beaver regulations as long as 'Gone with the Wind'" is still remembered in the department, according to a letter from the commissioner upon his retirement. After retirement, he devoted himself to genealogy, bringing to it the same sense of professional standards that he embodied as a game biologist.

After the death of his wife, Patricia, in 1991, he remained well connected to his children and grandchildren, following their lives and careers with great interest. He lived most of his professional and family life in Bingham, where he was Master of the Masonic Lodge, Patron of the Order of Eastern Star, member of the American Legion, volunteer fireman, and Boy Scout leader. In 1996, he returned to Fairfield, where he entered a very loving relationship with his brother Richard's widow, Betty F. Hunt, who was his beloved companion and wife until his death. In addition to his second wife, he is survived by five children, Jean Murphy and husband, Patrick, of Maryland, Barbara Striker and husband, Dennis, of Maryland, John C. Hunt (Jack) of Waterville, Louise Savage and husband, George, of Sydney, and Timothy S. and wife, Kristi, of Georgia; and 10 grandchildren.

His son, James, died previously. He is also survived by brothers, Donald and H. Thomas Hunt, and a sister, Margaret Carter; his step-family, David, Martha, Joshua and Samantha Hunt of Fairfield, and Richard Hunt of Vermont.

Visiting hours will be held from 6 to 8 p.m. Tuesday, Jan. 7, at Giberson Funeral Home, 18 River St., Bingham. A memorial service will be held at noon, Wednesday, Jan. 8, at the Fairfield Center United Methodist Church. Interment will be at the Maine Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Augusta.
