# **Leroy F. Hussey Sr.**

## **businessman, legislator for Augusta area**

AUGUSTA – Leroy F. Hussey Sr., 96, died Sunday at the Maine Veteran's Home.

He was born here, son of Edgar A. and Lillian Parks Hussey, and attended the University of Maine two years until he enlisted in the Army and served with the 56th Pioneer Infantry in World War I.

At the end of the war, he entered Boston University, graduating in 1921.

In 1923, he married Ruth Vickery of Augusta. She died in 1969.

With his father and brother, Mr. Hussey founded Hussey Hardware Co. in 1921, serving as president until his retirement in 1981 and on the board of directors until 1993.

In 1971, he married Clara H. Arthur of Kingston, Ontario. She died in 1976.

Mr. Hussey was a member of Augusta's Board of Aldermen from 1925 to 1929, and was chairman from 1927 to 1929.

He was the first chairman of the Augusta Police Commission and a former member of the Augusta and Kennebec County Republican committees.

From 1931 to 1934, he was a member of the House of Representatives and of the Senate from 1935 to 1938.

Mr. Hussey was a member of the Governor's Executive Council from 1947 to 1952, serving as chairman in 1951-52.

He was a candidate for governor in 1952.

A past president of the Augusta Kiwanis Club and Red Cross, he also was a past exalted ruler of the Elks and a director of the Bank of Maine until 1985.

He was a past master of the Augusta Lodge of Masons, a past high priest of the Cushnoc Chapter, Royal Arch of Masons, a past potentate of Kora Temple Shrine and a past director of Put Stevens Court, Royal Order of Jesters.

Mr. Hussey served on the state YMCA camp committee, and was a member of Kennebec Valley Chamber of Commerce, Maine State Grange, the Order of the Eastern Star, the Fitzgerald-Cummings Post, American Legion, and the Scottish and York Rite bodies. He was a

**MARS HILL** - Stetson H. "Ted" Hussey Jr., 86, died March 31, 2005 at a Bangor hospital. He was born June 20, 1918, in Mars Hill, the son of Stetson H. and Gladys (Goodhue) Hussey Sr.

He was an Eagle Scout at the age of 14. He was a 1937 graduate from Aroostook Central Institute in Mars Hill. He graduated from Bowdoin College in 1941 and from Boston University School of Law in 1948. Ted became associated with his father, Stetson H. Hussey Sr. in the practice of Law in Mars Hill on May 8, 1948, to the present time. He was a veteran of World War II, 1st Lieutenant and served in the South Pacific for 38 months, his platoon being assigned to various Regimental Combat Teams. Ted was a member and Past President of the Aroostook Bar Association and a member of the Maine Bar Association. He was an advisory director of the Northern National Bank for approximately 20 years. He was one of the Founding Fathers of the Aroostook Health Center in Mars Hill; a Charter Member and Past President of the Mars Hill Rotary Club and was a Paul Harris Fellow. Ted was a

member of the American Legion Post No. 118, Mars Hill, a member of Aroostook Masonic Lodge No. 197, Mars Hill and a member of the Mars Hill United Methodist church. He was a member of the Aroostook Valley Country Club and the Mars Hill Country Club. In 1998, Ted was presented a plaque for Outstanding Citizen of the Year and Role Model; a plaque presented for Outstanding Service for the Support of Girl Scouting and the "Health 2000 Youth Educating Youth" Program, a plaque presented by the Maine State Bar Association in recognition of 50 Years of practice in the legal profession; and a medal for 50 years membership in the Masonic Lodge.

He is survived by his wife, Clara (Towle) Hussey whom he married on Sept. 17, 1948; a son, Bruce L. Hussey, an attorney in Missoula, Mont.; a sister, Mary H. MacBride of Presque Isle; a niece, Barbara H. Bishop of Presque Isle; a nephew, M. Milton MacBride Jr. of Yarmouth; and two special friends, his legal secretaries, Mavis J. Burchell and Loretta B. Jones.

Funeral services will be held 3 p.m. Sunday, at the Mars Hill United Methodist Church with the Rev. Bethann Black officiating. Relatives and friends may call 1-3 p.m. Sunday, at the church. Interment will be in Kings Grove Cemetery in Mars Hill later in the spring. ## Almer J. Huston

The burial office and requiem for Almer J. Huston, veteran book store proprietor, will be conducted at 10 a. m. Friday in the Cathedral Church of St. Luke.

11/23 Mr. Huston died Tuesday in his home, 68 Neal Street, after several months of failing health. For the past 38 years he had conducted the A. J. Huston Book Store at 92 Exchange Street, and since 1890 had been actively identified with the book and stationery business, first at Rockland, then in Portland.

Born at Lincolnville, Sept. 5, 1869, son of Alonzo and Mary Gilkey Huston, he opened a book and stationery store, which still bears his name, at Rockland in 1890, operating it until he came to Portland in 1910.

He purchased the local store from the late Alfred L. Colesworthy, the son of Samuel Colesworthy who established the shop. Mr. Huston claimed that his store was the second oldest bookstore in New England. The Old Corner Book Store in Boston, established in 1828, is older.

While the store had many old volumes, Mr. Huston had pointed out in the past that the great amount of his business was in books that were popular as recently as 15 or 20 years ago.

A booster of Maine authors, he regarded their books "as good as any and better than most."

At a booksellers' convention in Boston at the end of the recent war, Mr. Huston was named the "pioneer book man" because during the war, when younger booksellers were jittery about paper shortages, he had counseled that by judging shortages in other wars, they would come through with but minor bruises.

He was a member of the Masons several years, joining Rockland Lodge, No. 79, in 1901. He was a member of the Portland Rotary Club, and for many years active in the Maine Society of Colonial Wars, its secretary until recently. He had served in the Greater Chapter of the Cathedral Church of St. Luke, also as a member of the vestry and an usher.

He was a member of the board of directors of the Homestead Savings & Loan Association and had continued on the board of the Casco Homestead Savings and Loan Association following the recent merger.

Last Jan. 27, he and his wife, Mrs. Kate L. Huston, who survives him, observed their golden wedding anniversary.

## Immigrant picked as top teacher

SALT LAKE CITY (AP) — Six years after leaving Vietnam, Luc Pham has been named Teacher of the Year for the Salt Lake City School District, where he has taught English to hundreds of students at Washington Elementary School.

Most of his 1st- through 6th-grade students are Asian, but with a minority enrollment of 40 percent the school draws students from many backgrounds. Luckily, Pham, 38, is fluent in five languages — Vietnamese, French, English, Chinese and Spanish.

Pham worked as a teacher, then as a translator and intelligence officer in the U.S. Embassy during the Vietnam War. He was cap-

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After graduation from Williams College in 1928, he was

trained as a forester at the University of Maine so he could manage his family's Dead River Co., which owned thousands of forest acres in Maine.

He also became president of the Bangor & Aroostook Railroad, director of the Association of American Railroads, president of the New England Council and a director of several major corporations.

Mr. Hutchins joined Dead River as treasurer in the early '30s and became its president and board chairman in 1935. He diversified the company by going into oil distribution and recreational land developments. Dead River became one of the larger oil distribution firms in Maine.

He became a Navy officer in World War II and was borrowed by the War Production Board to head up its paper division. In that role he handled paper allocations and directed a program in which the government tried, unsuccessfully, to turn German prisoners of war into pulpwood cutters.

In 1944 he became a director of the Bangor & Aroostook, served as president from 1948-57 and two years thereafter as board chairman.

As president, he dieselized the "potato road" locomotives within three years, speeded up service, cut freight rates and modernized rolling stock.

Mr. Hutchins was instrumental in creating Bangor Punta Corp., a nationwide conglomerate that later acquired Piper Aircraft and was in turn taken over by Lear Siegler.

He was a Bangor Punta director and served on numerous other boards.

An active Republican, he represented Bangor in the Maine House in 1943 and was on the Bangor City Council for several years.

In 1975, Mr. Hutchins was appointed a member of the Roosevelt-Campobello International Park Commission.

Mr. Hutchins and his wife donated \$1 million to the University of Maine's School of Forest Resources in 1981. The gift was dedicated to starting programs and courses and to the creation of professorships.

He never outgrew his fascination for the Maine woods and was an avid salmon fisherman. Last Friday he attended a supper of the Mirimichi Salmon Club at Boesdown, New Brunswick, where he was publicly recognized for his lifelong contributions to the sport. He spent part of Saturday picnicking with former baseball great Ted Williams, a friend of many years. He received honorary degrees

from Colby College in Waterville in 1949, the University of Maine in 1951, Husson College in 1971 and from Thomas College in 1985.

He was a director of American Woolen Co., Atlas Plywood Corp., Avis Inc., Bangor Punta Corp., Guilford Industries Inc., Merrill Trust Co., Scott Paper Co., State Street Bank and Trust Co. of Boston and Northeast Airlines Inc.

At the time of his death, he was commissioner of Roosevelt Campobello International Park, a trustee of the College of the Atlantic in Bar Harbor and a member of Phi Beta Kappa. He was also a member of the University of Maine Pulp and Paper Foundation and a trustee of Bangor Theological Seminary.

He was a past member of the Maine Environmental Improvement Commission and the Bangor City Council, serving as its chairman in 1943.

He was a member of the American Pulpwood Association and was its president in 1946 and 1947.

He was a member of the Colby College Investment Committee, the Maine Higher Education Committee, the Canadian-American Committee of the National Planning Association, the United Nations Mission to Chile in 1959, the Governors Committee of Forest Legislation, the State Credit Research Committee, the Governor's Seed Committee (chairman) and a member and trustee of Eastern Maine General Hospital.

Mr. Hutchins was a past director of Maine Development Corp. and the Association of American Railroads.

He was a member of the Brook Club of New York City, the Pinnacle Club of New York City, the Union Club of Boston, the Penobscot Valley Country Club, the Downtown Club of Boston, Tarrantine Club and the Pot and Kettle Club of Bar Harbor.

Surviving are a son, Christopher of Bangor, and two daughters, Hope Blackburn of New York and Hilda McCollom of Chevy Chase, Md. His wife of 53 years, Ruth Rich Hutchins, died in December 1984.

The memorial service will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at All Souls Congregational Church, Broadway, Bangor. The Revs. G. Wayne Glick and Arlan D. Baillie will officiate. Burial will be in Mount Hope Cemetery.

WELLS - Elmer C. Hutchins, 79, of High Pine, retired chief of police for the towns of Wells and North Berwick, died Thursday at a local hospital.

Chief Hutchins was town constable in Wells during the 1930s and later served many years as the town's only officer. As the force grew over the years, Hutchins used to joke that it took about 20 officers to do the job he did by himself, said his son, Norman Hutchins of Wells.

Elmer Hutchins served 24 years as a Wells officer, serving as chief for part of that time. In the late 1960s, he became chief of the North Berwick Police Department.

Chief Hutchins was shot in August 1975 while investigating a domestic dispute. As he approached a house where there had been a complaint of a knifing, he was shot by an 18-year-old with a rifle.

Chief Hutchins retired shortly after that incident, later working as a security guard for Coastal Security Co., Kennebunk, and then for Ness Security Co. guarding

Plant in Sanford.

Born in Wells, he was a son of Edward F. and Izetta Hilton Hutchins, and attended Wells schools.

He served in the National Guard during World War II.

Chief Hutchins was twice a selectman in Wells, for eight years during the 1940s and four years during the 1970s. He had to step down while he was police chief.

He was a former Wells road commissioner, a longtime member of the Wells Corner Hose Company and a York County deputy sheriff for several years.

A former treasurer of the High Pine Baptist Church, he was also a member of the Ocean Lodge of Masons of High Pine, the Kora Temple Shrine and the Odd Fellows.

Hutchins was a 65-year member and past master of Elm Brook Grange and a past master of York County Pomona Grange. He was a member of the North Berwick Rod and Gun Club, the National Rifle Association and the Sportsmen's Alliance of Maine.

He was a past commander of the Eldridge and Leroy Hanson Post American Legion, a charter member and past president of the Maine Law Enforcement Association and a former member of the Maine Chief of Police Association.

His wife, Alice Babineau Hutchins, died in 1969.

He is survived by a son, Norman of Wells; a daughter, Kathleen Sternfeld of Gaithersburg, Md.; a sister, Esther Boston of North Berwick; seven grandchildren and a
