He was employed for 28 years by Railway Express Agency, moving to Ellsworth in 1932, where he served as an agent for 13 years. He bought Wescott's Hardware Store in 1941. He was a member of United Baptist Church of Ellsworth, a charter member and past president of the Rotary Club, served on the Ellsworth City Council, past president of Ellsworth Luncheon Club, and also the Ellsworth Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Ingalls was commodore of the Patten Bay Yacht Club and a director of the Retired Skippers Race. He was a member of St. Andrew's Masonic Lodge AF & AM of Bangor, Acadia Chapter and Blaquafort Commandery of Ells-

worth, and Anah Temple Shrine of Bangor. Raleigh was predeceased by his wife of 62 years, Hildred (Johnson) Ingalls. He is survived by a daughter and son-in-law, Katherine and Howard L. Ehrlenbach; four grandsons, Richard, Frederick, Lincoln and Kenneth; six great-grandchildren, Heidi, Maria, Heather, Raleigh Frederick II, Erin and Ashley, all of Ellsworth; his second wife, Noreen (Proctor) Ingalls; a sister, Mrs. Avis Pettegrew; three brothers, Newton, Howard and Kenneth Ingalls, all of Bucks Harbor. 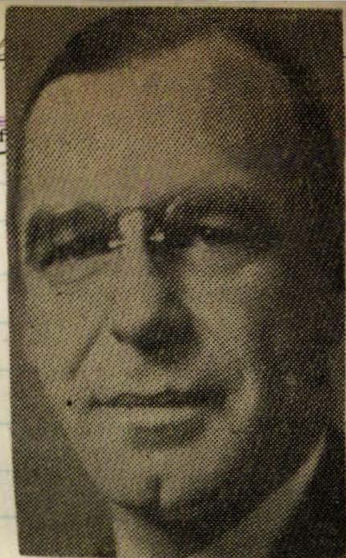

Ralph M. Ingalls, 50, former county attorney of Cumberland County and widely-known criminal attorney here 29 years, died suddenly of a heart disease at 3 p. m. Sunday at his home, 24 Wadsworth Street.

Ingalls, believed on the way to recovery after a serious illness in the Maine General Hospital last Fall, arose and dressed Sunday morning but returned to bed not feeling well. He told associates at his office at 119 Exchange Street, Saturday that he felt a slight pain in his side but believed it nothing serious. He had been coming into the office quite regularly since the first of the year.

Ingalls achieved State-wide recognition as a prosecutor during his three terms as Cumberland County Attorney from 1924 to 1930, so much so that he was called several times afterward as special assistant attorney general in important criminal cases in various parts of Maine.

It was while he was acting as assistant to Attorney General Franz U. Burkett last Fall in preparing the State's case against William A. Runnells, former State controller now serving a prison term for embezzlement, that Ingalls first was stricken with heart disease.

Ingalls was known for his colorful manner in the courtroom as well as a public speaker before many civic organizations. He won recognition for his prosecution of Frank M. Carroll, former Oxford County deputy sheriff, who in the Fall of 1938 was convicted of the slaying of Dr. James G. Littlefield at South Paris.

Ingalls was born at Bridgton, May, 6, 1890, the son of Joseph Palmer and Dolly Richardson Ingalls. He attended Bridgton High School and was graduated from the law school of the University of Maine in 1912. He started practicing law upon graduation, and was deputy clerk of Superior Court from 1915 to 1921 and assistant attorney from 1921 un-

til election as County Attorney. Ingalls was appointed a special assistant to the Attorney General's Department in 1932 during the absence of Attorney General Clement F. Robinson. Ingalls' record was cited for commendation by the Wickersham Committee, appointed by President Herbert Hoover to study means for more effective law enforcement.

Ingalls is survived by his widow, Mrs. Edith G. Binford Ingalls whom he married in 1932; a sister, Mrs. John Johnson of Westbrook; and several nieces and nephews.

He was drafted from Westbrook Board No. Two during the World War and sent to Camp Devens. He was sent back from Camp Devens as clerk of the same draft board, and was honorably discharged from the Army upon his election as Westbrook City Solicitor and his appointment as Assistant County Attorney.

He was a member of the Woodfords and Elks Clubs, the Masonic Blue Lodge, Chapter and Commandery at Bridgton, the Shrine, the Edward Lopeman Post, American Legion, at Bridgton, and the Cumberland and American Bar Associations.

Funeral services will be held from the Williston Congregational Church at 1.30 p. m. Wednesday with the Rev. Franklin P. Cole officiating. Prayers will be said at the Bridgton Congregational Church.

An active Democrat for many years, Mr. Ingalls was chairman of the Democratic Town Committee in the late 1950s.

He also led a fund-raising drive for the construction of the Kennebunk Youth Center at Parsons Field. The center was recently reactivated after serving as a

school for troubled teen-agers for several years.

Mr. Ingalls enjoyed hunting and fishing.

"He used to hunt down in the old pasture off the Durrell's Bridge Road," said his son, Brian Ingalls. "Dad was hunting with a group of guys once when he put buck lure on before he walked into the pasture. As the story goes, a dozen or so cows followed him, mooing and bellowing and chasing him down to the lower end of the pasture."

Born in Wakefield, Mass., a son of Frank T. and Lillian Oxley Ingalls, he attended Newton, Mass., and Kennebunk schools.

He was a sergeant in the Army and served in Italy during World War II.

Mr. Ingalls was a life member of Kennebunk American Legion, a member of the York Masons and the Royal Arch Society, a member and past patron of the Order of Eastern Star and a dad adviser for the Rainbow Girls.

He lived for many years on Main Street in West Kennebunk.

Surviving are his wife of 53 years, Luella Wyman Ingalls of West Kennebunk; two sons, Raymond T. Jr. and Brian A., both of Kennebunk; a brother, Kenneth, of Wiscasset; and four grandchildren.
