Andrew P. Iverson Sr. plumbing and heating contractor

FALMOUTH — Andrew P. Iverson Sr., a plumber and businessman who was a strong supporter of his community, died Thursday at a local nursing home.

He was 88 and a former resident of Edgewater Road. He was born here, a son of Iver H. Iverson III and Marie Gram Iverson, attended local schools and graduated from Deering High School in 1928.

PASSAGES

Each day the newspaper selects one obituary and seeks to learn more about the life of a person who has lived and worked in Maine. We look for a person who has made a mark on the community or the person's family and circle of friends in small but lasting ways.

He attended the Maine Central Institute in Pittsfield before attending the University of Maine at Orono, where he graduated in 1934. He was a member of Lambda Chi Fraternity.

In 1934 he married the former Wilma McBride of Westbrook. She died in December 1997 after 63 years of marriage.

During World War II, Mr. Iverson served in the Navy in the Aleutian Islands, where he was a chief petty officer. In August 1945 he was stationed at Fort Gorges in Portland Harbor.

After the war he founded the Andrew P. Iverson Plumbing Co. in Falmouth.

In 1931 he purchased the Scribner and Iverson Plumbing Firm, Portland, with his cousin, Iver Iverson.

Mr. Iverson retired from the firm in 1977.

He served as president of the Maine State Association of Plumbing, Heating and Cooling Contractors in 1951-1952. He was District 1 director of the National Association of Plumbing, Heating and Cooling Contractors from 1976 to 1978.

He also represented the United Association of Plumbers and Pipefitters, Local 217.

During this time he worked at Maine Medical Center, Eastern Maine Medical Center at Bangor, Maine Yankee in Wiscasset and the Bowdoin College skating rink.

His son, Dr. Andrew Iverson of Freeport, said his father was "quite service minded to the community."

Mr. Iverson helped found the Lions Club in Falmouth, was a commander of the Falmouth American Legion Memorial Post and a member of the Falmouth School Board.

"I think it was a combination of the sociability of it and being service-minded," his son said of his father's efforts to found the Lions Club.

"He always worked hard on their auctions."

He was also a strong supporter of the Shriners, who help support a burn hospital. "He always believed in that," his son said.

Mr. Iverson was also a charter member of the Forest City chapter of the Order of the DeMolay. In 1932 he joined the Atlantic Lodge, now merged with Triangle Lodge, Portland.

He was an honorary member of the Westbrook Council, a member of the Greenleaf Chapter, Portland, St. Alban's Commandery, Scottish Rite Valley, Portland, the Kora Temple Shrine, Lewiston, the Royal Order of Jesters, Put Stevens Court, the Lake Region and Portland Kora Shrine clubs and was an associate member of Sahib Temple, Sarasota, Fla.

He was also a member of the Woodfords Club and past commodore of the Venerable Cunner & Propeller Club.

He was a strong family man, too. He would often take his wife or his son hunting and fishing in Eustis.

"He was very fond of Eustis," his son said.

"He had a place there since after the war. He knew the town very well."

Andrew Iverson said his father "worked real hard in his business, and he enjoyed life."

Surviving are one son, Dr. Andrew P. Jr. of Freeport; one daughter, Carol I. Kauffman of Meadowbrook, Pa.; five grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

Visiting hours will be 6 to 8 p.m. Sunday at Jones, Rich and Hutchins Funeral Home, Portland, and from 9 to 10 a.m. Monday at the Falmouth Congregational Church.

A funeral service will follow at 10 a.m. Monday at the church with the Rev. Dawn Berry officiating.

Burial will be in Pine Grove Cemetery.

chairman of the Cornish Republican Committee. A big, friendly man, Mr. Jack was well-known and respected in his community. "You don't get to be a Commander of the American Legion or elected to offices 20 or 30 times without being liked," said his brother, Carleton Jack. "If we had more like him, we'd be all set."

Mr. Jack was a member of the Greenleaf Lodge of Masons in Cornish, the Corona Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star and the Francis Sullivan Post of the American Legion. He also was a member of the West Day Veterans of Foreign Wars Post and the McLaughlin Veterans of Foreign Wars Post in Hiram.

Following the war, Mr. Jack was employed by the Boston and Maine Railroad in Boston for two years.

In the early 1950s, Mr. Jack moved to Cornish to help manage the Lincoln Hotel. He held that position until the inn was sold in 1975. In 1976, he came to Kennebunk Beach, where he operated the Wentworth Hotel each summer until the hotel was sold.

After his retirement from the hotel industry, he was an associate broker representing Century 21 First Choice Realty in Gorham. He spent his winters in Largo after becoming a dialysis patient. When he had spare time, which wasn't often, he enjoyed going to the Fryeburg Fair to watch the sulky horse races.
