


Eventually, he bought out his partners, and has since carried on alone and has seen his business increase from year to year, and for some time had been associated with the S. S.

nursing home.




Surviving are his wife, the former Kathleen Putnam; a son, Ralph C. Jr. of Portland; a brother, Kenneth E. of




