Norway, June 19—Funeral services for Ernest B. Jackson were held from the Raymond funeral home with the Rev. William P. Farnsworth officiating. The bearers were James N. Favor, Norman U. Greenlaw, Fred E. Smith, Stuart W. Goodwin, Burton A. Shaw and Philip Wight. Burial was at Norway Pine Grove Cemetery.

Mr. Jackson died at his home on Deering Street. He had been ill for some months, but attended to his business, seldom missing a day. He was born at West Paris, Oct. 31, 1881, son of Benjamin and Lydia Knapp Jackson. Coming to Norway 40 years ago, he was employed in the Canadian Express office for G. L. Curtis, agent, for over a year, then for a time worked in the shoe factory. Thirty-two years ago, he opened a grocery store on Main Street, and a few years later N. U. Greenlaw and N. N. Holden were associated with him.

Eventually, he bought out his partners, and has since carried on alone and has seen his business increase from year to year, and for some time had been associated with the S. S. Pierce Company, Boston.

Mr. Jackson was a member of the Masonic lodges, the Commandery, and the Shrine and of Oxford Chapter, OES, Norway Board of Trade, and the Norway Merchants' Association.

He leaves his wife, Retta Berry Jackson, a son Nolan B. Jackson, who has been associated with his father since graduating from college, a grandson, Ernest-Nolan Jackson, and a brother, George Jackson of West Paris.

Surviving, besides his wife of nearly 62 years, Agnes Whicher Jackson, are two daughters, Mrs. David (Janice) Holbrook of Cape Porpoise and Mrs. Jack (Kathleen) Harrison of Kennebunk; a son, Gordon R. of Orlando, Fla.; eight grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
