Biddeford, Dec. 4.—Daniel L. Jelleson, widely known Biddeford resident, retired grocer, and for many years employed as an assistant cashier by the Boston and Maine Railroad Company in Charlestown, Mass., died at his home, 112 Graham Street, today, following a week's illness with pneumonia.

He was born here, the son of Judge Abel H. and Sarah Dudley Jelleson. He was graduated from Biddeford High School, and after leaving school obtained employment at the John Berry drug store on Main Street. Later he was employed by and became a member of the firm of A. H. Jelleson and Son, grocers, Water Street.

Following the death of his father, he went to Boston, where he was employed by the S. S. Pierce Company as a clerk. His next place of em-

ployment was with the Boston and Maine, as assistant cashier in the freight department.

After a year passed in California when he left the employ of the railroad Mr. and Mrs. Jelleson returned to Maine, first residing in Portland and later in Biddeford. His wife died a few months ago.

He was a member of all of the local Masonic bodies, and was one of the oldest members of Adah Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star. He was an attendant of the White Church.

Besides a son, Harold P. Jelleson of Biddeford, he leaves three nephews, Philip C. Staples of Philadelphia, John and Frank Staples of Lynn, Mass., and a cousin, Mrs. Fannie L. Smart of Biddeford.

Funeral services will be conducted Wednesday at 2.30 p. m. at the home and will be private. Friends may call between the hours of 12 and 1 o'clock.

"He gave that license up," said his wife. "But he always yearned to have it back. It was one of the earliest licenses given out in Maine."

Mr. Jenkins kept a room in his house for repairing, building and operating his radio equipment. He had maps on the wall with pins all over them, indicating the many places in the world where he had communicated.

He was described by his wife as a friendly person, who enjoyed meeting people, and who had a spontaneous sense of humor.

As a young man, he worked at Standard Shoe Store in Bangor.

In the early 1930s, he was a member of the 152nd Field Artillery of the National Guard, which was then a horse unit. "Many a story he could tell about the horses," said his wife.

In 1945, he served as chief electrician aboard the Frontenac, a United States "Victory" class ship. The Frontenac sailed in a convoy of supply ships in the North Atlantic toward the end of World War II. "He said the harbors in Holland and Belgium were full of sunken ships when he arrived," said his wife.

Starting in the 1940s, he worked for Ballard Oil Co. of Portland, installing heavy oil heating systems in large

William G. Jenkins, 64, of Washington Avenue, a carpenter and longtime postal worker, died Saturday of cancer at a local hospital.

"He was a very gentle man, and very hard working," said his wife of 43 years, Bernice D. (Flanssen) Jenkins of Portland.

Mr. Jenkins was born in Waltham, Mass., a son of William A. and Louise (Tuzzard) Jenkins, and attended schools there.

Like other family members, he took a strong interest in carpentry. In 1944, he went to work for Merrill, Chapman & Scott, a construction company based in New York City.

During his four years with the company, he worked on the construction of the Amesbury and Mystic River (Tobin) Bridges in Massachusetts. Mr. Jenkins pre-

marily worked on the foundations of the bridges, while his uncle served as superintendent and his father was foreman.

It was while working on these projects that Mr. Jenkins met his future wife. She originally lived in nearby Watertown, but when she moved to Portland, he came to visit on the weekends.

"He was quite the suitor, always the gentleman," she said. The couple married in 1951, and had lived at their Washington Avenue home ever since.

Soon after marrying, Mr. Jenkins was drafted to serve in the Korean War in October 1952. He served in the Engineers Corps near Seoul, South Korea, and was the "company carpenter," his wife said.

"Anything they needed built, he was the man," she said. His main work was building metal footbridges, but he also delivered ammunition to the front. Mr. Jenkins was due to be promoted to sergeant when he was discharged in 1954.

Upon returning to Portland, he worked briefly for Bodwell Leighton, an automobile repair shop on Cumberland Avenue, and also worked for the Maine Turnpike Authority.

In the late 1950s, Mr. Jenkins was hired by the U.S. Postal Service in Portland, where he worked as a postal clerk for 25 years.

"He was a master with every Maine zip code," his wife said. "He was a very hard worker, and took pride in the mail getting where it had to go."

His wife said Mr. Jenkins "was friends with everybody" and took a great pride in helping people. "If someone needed a tow, or a loan, he was always there," she said. "He had a huge heart."

In his spare time, Mr. Jenkins enjoyed golfing. He, never joined a club, but played most of his golf over the last 25 years at Riverside Municipal Golf Course.



Mr. Jenkins also was interested in woodworking, making a variety of furniture for family and friends. His last project was a bathroom cabinet for his wife, completed last year.

Mr. Jenkins was a member of St. Paul's Anglican Church, the Triangle Lodge of Masons and the Veterans of Foreign Wars in South Portland.

Besides his wife, survivors include two sisters, Margaret Jenkins and Frances Plantidosi, both of Fontana, Calif.

Burial Office and requiem Mass will be celebrated at 2 p.m. Tuesday at St. Paul's Anglican Church, 279 Congress St. The Rev. Harold McElwain will officiate.

He was born Nov. 1, 1900, in South Danbury, N.H., the son of George B. and Melvina A. (Beane) Jenness. Dr. Jenness received his bachelor of science degree from the University of New Hampshire in 1922, earned a master of science degree in 1925 from the University of Maine and did additional graduate work at MIT. In 1966 the University of New Hampshire awarded him an honorary doctorate. Dr. Jenness had retired from the University of Maine after a 41-year career as an instructor, professor and head of the department of chemical engineering, and pulp and paper.
