

### Air Force officer, meteorologist

RICHMOND, Va. - Edward Orland Jess, 77, of Richmond, a retired Air Force colonel, died Sunday.

Born in Westbrook, Maine, he attended schools there and graduated from Westbrook High School as salutatorian in 1935.

For a time, he taught in Westbrook schools.

Mr. Jess worked at S.D. Warren Co. from 1936 to 1939. He received a B.S. degree from the former Gorham (Maine) Normal School in 1939, studied meteorology at Massachusetts Institute of Technology in 1942, and received an M.S. from New York University in 1948 and a Ph.D. from the University of Stockholm, Sweden, in 1958.

In 1941, he enlisted in the Army and served for 31 years, the last eight as a colonel in the Air Force. He commanded weather detachments, a squadron and two groups during World War II in New Guinea and the Philippines. He established the National Filipino Weather Bureau after World War II. He directed all weather support for the Berlin Airlift in 1948 and managed research and development of geophysical support of the National Space and Missile Ranges from 1960 to 1964. He was the director of Asia-Pacific Weather, Central Tokyo from 1964 to 1967, and served in Vietnam.

From 1972 to 1982, he was employed by the state air Pollution Control Board as meteorologist and director of the Episode Control Center.

Mr. Jess had been a member of the American Meteorological Society since 1944. He was president of the three largest local chapters in the United States and Tokyo. He was listed in American Men of Science.

He was a member of Temple Masonic Lodge, Westbrook, the Scottish Rite, Richmond Consistory, Afifi Temple of the Shrine, the National Sojourners and Heroes of '76. He also was a member of the National Association of Atomic Veterans, and National Association of Radiation Survivors and the Westhampton United Methodist Church.

His wife, Ruby C. Jess, died previously.

Surviving are a half-brother and many nieces and nephews.

A funeral will be held at 7:30 p.m. today at Bennett Funeral Home, 3215 Cutshaw Ave. Burial will be in Westbrook.
