





He was a member of Phoenix Lodge AF&AM in Belfast and of the Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen and Conductors.





Elbridge A. Johnson of 32/Orland Street, former division engineer of the entire Maine Central Railroad system and an employe of the railroad 43 years, died Thursday in the Maine General Hospital of heart disease.
