Sumner W. Johnson of 21 Longfellow Street, former Portland city official and for more than a quarter of a century prominent in loan and building association activities in this city and the state, died this morning in the Maine General Hospital. In failing health several months, he entered the hospital a week ago today. He would have been 77 years old Saturday.

Mr. Johnson was active in Republican politics in the city in former years. He served in the Common Council and the Board of Aldermen under the bicameral form of city government, and was for five years city messenger, his last service in this position being under Mayor Adam P. Leighton, 1908-09.
