Walter Raymond Johnson, 69

WINDHAM -- Walter Raymond Johnson, 69, of Windham died peacefully at Maine Medical Center from complications of a stroke.

He was born in Windham, the son of Merton and Catherine Pratt Johnson. A lifelong resident of Windham, he graduated from Windham High School and Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute where he excelled in basketball and learned the skills in building which he used throughout his lifetime. As a young man he was pioneer in the sport of competitive water skiing, and was a founding member of the Luckson Water Ski Club in Windham. Walter worked at Windham Millwork, Inc. for 49 years in various capacities, starting as an apprentice, cabinetmaker, and became part-owner for a time before his retirement. Even when retired, he enjoyed being a consultant for the company and worked part-time there.

Walt was an avid outdoorsman, who loved hunting, fishing, snowmobiling and golfing. He spent many happy days at the log camp in Rangeley which he and his father built in 1991. He hosted golf and snowmobile weekends for his Windham Millwork co-workers, family and friends. He was able to build almost anything out of wood, and completely furnished his camp with pieces which he handcrafted.

Active as well in the community, he drew the plans for the Windham Library, designed the Welcome to Windham signs, and designed and built the steeple for the Advent Christian Church. He had an inventive mind and was able to solve any problem presented to him with insight and skill. He was a member of Presumpscot Lodge, 127 A.F. & A. M., St. Alban Commandery, Kora Shriners, and was past president of the Lake Region Shrine Club in Windham. He and his father built and sold canes for the benefit of Shriners Children's Hospitals and at the time of his death had crafted over 600 Masonic canes and donated the entire proceeds of the sale of these canes to the hospital.

He was predeceased by a twin brother, Warren. He is survived by his parents, Merton and Catherine Pratt Johnson; his wife of 47 years, Sylvia Wheeler Johnson; his two daughters, Sandra Avery and her husband Linc of Cumberland, and Cynthia Chamberlain and her husband Steven of Scarborough; three wonderful grandchildren of whom he was so proud, Amanda and Kevin Chamberlain of Scarborough, and Sarah Avery of Cumberland. He is also survived by his brother John and his wife Joan of Windham.
