### Johnston Funeral Sunday

Funeral services for Thomas M. Johnston, 81, in business here several years before moving to Media, Penna., upon his retirement in 1914, will be held at 2 p. m., Daylight Time, Sunday, in Wilde Memorial Chapel. Interment will be in Evergreen Cemetery.

Mr. Johnston died early Friday morning in a local hospital after a short illness. Born at Cornwall, N. Y., May 1, 1852, he came to Portland when he was 17 years old and entered the employment of Marrett and Bailey, dealers in house furnishings. When Mr. Marrett retired, Mr. Johnston became a member of the firm, known as Johnston and Bailey, and in 1900 purchased the business and conducted it until his retirement in 1914. Since that time he had lived at Media, where his daughter, Mrs. C. A. Woodbury, also resides. He spent his Summers at his farm at Raymond.

Mr. Johnston was an alderman on the first board after Deering became a city. He was a member of the Masons and Odd Fellows and attended the Friends Church while living here.

Besides his daughter at Media he is survived by another daughter, Mrs. Theo Drinkwater of Portland, and two grandchildren, Mrs. Gordon McLeod and Clifford A. Woodbury, Jr., both of Media.

Belfast, March 7.—Edwin Albert Jones, 74, one of the most widely known hotel men in Maine, having spent the greater part of his life in the business, died early today in his apartment in the Windsor Hotel, after a short illness. Death was due to internal hemorrhage.

Eight years ago he sold his interest in the Windsor and had spent his Summers at his cottage at Northport, while Winters, with the exception of this, were spent in St. Petersburg, Fla. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of the Mystic Shrine.
