Thomaston, Nov. 14—Funeral services for Albert R. Jordan, 71, who died last Saturday at his home in Thomaston, were held on Tuesday at his late home, the Rev. H. S. Kilborn of the Thomaston Baptist Church officiating. Burial was in South Warren Cemetery.

Mr. Jordan was born in Thomaston, the son of William and Rebecca (Copeland) Jordan. He was employed at South Warren a few years with the section crew of the Maine Central Railroad and later lived in Woolwich, where he was promoted to section foreman on the same railroad. Later he moved to Rockland and worked for some years on the Limerock Railroad. The latter part of his life was spent in his native town of Thomaston, and nearly every Spring since 1917, he has built a weir at the South Warren toll bridge for the taking of alewives which he cured and smoked for the market.

Mr. Jordan would next year have been a 50 year member of Aurora Lodge, F. A. M., of Thomaston. He

was a member of the First Baptist Church of Rockland, of Goodwill Grange, South Warren, and of Georges River Lodge, K. of P., of Warren.

He is survived by his wife, Mabel Copeland Jordan of Thomaston; one son, Henry Jordan of Rockland, one granddaughter; two brothers, Willis K., of South Warren and Charles of Brunswick; and one sister, Miss Zetta Jordan of Brunswick.

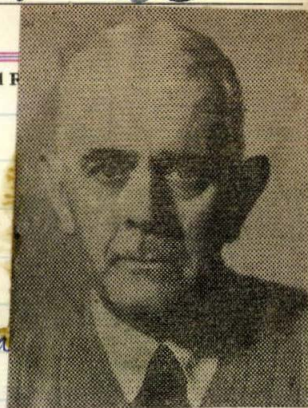
