AUBURN - Harry C. Jordan, 90, of 156 Main St. died Tuesday at Clover Manor Nursing Home.

Mr. Jordan was born in Turner, a son of Arthur and Annie Conant Jordan, and attended schools in Turner and Auburn. He also attended the Maine School of Commerce and the Franklin Institute.

He moved here at an early age and worked for Turner Center Creamery until going into the grocery business.

On Nov. 6, 1921, he married Ora Mae Donovan. She died in 1987.

A licensed real estate broker, he was actively engaged in the buying and selling of real estate from 1925 on.

He was employed by the Naval Air Station at Brunswick and at the Lewiston-Auburn Airport. He was appointed special wartime deputy sheriff during construction of the L-A airport and later as a firefighter for the duration of the war.

He was a toll collector for the Maine Turnpike Authority for 10 years, retiring in 1967. After retiring he owned and operated a locksmith business.

Mr. Jordan was a former member of the Maine State Employees Association, the Mount David Commandery in Lewiston, and was a knight of the Ancient and Illustrious Order of the Knights of Malta. He was raised to the Red Cross and Sepulchre Degree. He became a member of Eureka Lodge, Knights of Pythias in 1920. He was a past grand chancellor of the Grand Lodge of Maine in 1954-55. He was made a life member in 1970 and

awarded the Golden Spur Degree of the order in 1971.

He was instrumental in acquiring the Pythian Building on Spring Street in 1949, and served 10 years as the treasurer of the building's corporation. He served 15 years as a trustee of the Pythian Relief Fund in Maine.

He was a long-time member of Ali Baba Temple Dramatic Order Knights of Khorassan, a royal prince and past imperial representative for four years. For many years he was a member of Eureka Temple, Pythian Sisters, also a member of Ancient Brothers Lodge, the Scottish Rite bodies of Lewiston Auburn and Consistory of Portland. He was a life member, past patron of the Pine Cone Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star. He was a life member of the Androscoggin Historical Society, the Turner Historical Society, and the Maine Old Cemetery Association.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Alexander (Beverly) McCracken of Falmouth; a brother, Edwin of Turner; two grandchildren and two great-granddaughters.

A funeral will be held at 1 p.m. Friday at the First Universalist Church. The Rev. Johanna Nichols will officiate. Burial will be in Mount Auburn Cemetery. Arrangements are by Dillingham and Son Memorial Chapel

Ellsworth, Dec. 26—Harvard C. Jordan, 63, Ellsworth postmaster and one of the prominent Democratic leaders in this city died early today. Funeral services will be conducted Sunday at 2 p. m., at the home on Lincoln Street, the Rev. Paul W. Olander officiating. Bearers will be John A. Haynes, Omar W. Tapley, Roger L. Higgins, Edward Parks, Harry Smith and Orrin Clements. Interment will be in Woodbine Cemetery.

Mr. Jordan had been in ill health for a little more than a year and a half as a result of a fall from the roof of a building where he was making some repairs, but although partially paralyzed he had until within the last day or two been able to attend to duties at the office.

Before becoming postmaster he was for about a quarter of a century engaged in the jewelry business. At first he was associated with A. W. Greeley and on the death of the latter took over the establishment.

He was a former alderman, former member of the school board and had served as chairman of the Democratic city committee. He was affiliated with the Masonic bodies, including Blanquefort Commandery, Knights Templar, and the Mystic Shrine, and was also a member of Lejok Lodge of Odd Fellows.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Margaret Jordan, and a sister, Ellen Jordan of Boston.
